Operation and Maintenance of Wastewater Irrigation
Spray Fields at the Rocky Branch Land Treatment Facility (LAS)
Request for Qualifications / Proposals (RFQ/P) #1801-12
Addendum No. 1**

Please amend / revise / adjust the RFQ/P documents as follows....

1. **Page 1, Project Overview: 5th Paragraph, last sentence:**
 - a. Add: *The selected CONTRACTOR'S agreement must include a Warranty as described herein.*
2. **Section 1, Description of Services, Item 1, Page 2, Crop Management:**
 - a. Add: *As the objective of the Crop Management RFQ is to improve operations at the LAS facility, the County will require that the harvested crops be removed from the plant site within 45 days of harvest.*
3. **Section 2, Crop Management, Item 5, Page 3:**
 - a. Add: *As the objective of the Crop Management RFQ is to improve operations at the LAS facility, the County will require that the harvested crops be removed from the plant site within 60 days of the bailing date. The selected CONTRACTOR shall date hay bales stored on site. All bales in a harvest shall receive the same date for purposes of tracking. Plant staff will monitor the inventory and the bailing date on stored hay bales for conformance with this requirement. If this requirement adds to the Proposer's cost of the services to be provided, the Proposer should include sufficient contingency in the Cost Proposal to cover said costs. The County will back-charge the selected CONTRACTOR a storage fee of \$1.00 per stored bale at day 61, plus \$1.00 per bale per month, for each month thereafter, as a pre-negotiated storage rate.*
4. **Section 2, Operations Management Services, Page 4:**
 - a. Add Item 7: *The selected CONTRACTOR'S agreement must include a Warranty for furnishing and installing new equipment, valves, piping. The selected CONTRACTOR shall provide a minimum 1-year Warranty on labor, parts and workmanship on new work or repairs on LAS facilities. The CONTRACTOR shall warrant the work for a minimum period of one (1) year after the date of acceptance for new work such as furnishing and installing new piping, valves or repair of same. At least one month before the end of the one-year Warranty period, an eleven (11) month inspection shall be conducted on each installation and repair with the OWNER and CONTRACTOR. The purpose of this inspection shall be to identify and correct work which has become defective during the Warranty Period.*
5. **Section 3, Submittal and Due Date, Page 5:** To avoid complications with email, Respondents should modify the following instruction
 - a. Delete: *Email one (1) pdf version of the Response, no later than February 15, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. local time, addressed to the Owner Contact as listed above.*

- b. Insert: *Upload one (1) pdf version of the Response, no later than February 1, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. local time, addressed to the Owner Contact as listed above to the Vendor Registry website.*
- c. To submit (upload) a Response:
- i. Please visit to the Finance Page of the Oconee County Board of Commissioners website at www.oconeecounty.com.
 - ii. One must be registered and logged on to Vendor Registry to submit (upload) a Response. (If you are already registered, please skip to step iii.).
 - iii. Please click the “Vendor Registration” link to the left-hand side of the page to complete the registration process. Once you have been emailed your login and password and completed the verification process, proceed to Step v.
 - iv. To login, visit the Vendor Registry, select “Quick Links” at the bottom right side of the Finance Page.
 - v. Click the “Bid Opportunities” link on the top left side of the Finance page or paste and click on the following:
