MALE PARENTING PROGRAM

Scope of Services

Escambia County Corrections is looking for a Social Worker Professional or Agency to provide Parenting Education to our male incarcerated population at the Escambia County Jail and Work Release Facilities.

The qualified instructor(s) will be qualified to render services and have experience working with families in Parenting Education. He/she should demonstrate the skills of knowing how to deal with conflict in a group setting.

The male participant will be involved in a curriculum that will increase his knowledge of being a positive role model and an active and willing participant in co-parenting, understanding a child's development, how to effectively discipline a child, and dealing with a behaviorally challenged child. The instructor(s) will maintain attendance records and will provide completion certificates and a letter of completion for the male participant.

The Parenting Class will be held in a group setting at least once a week with the maximum number of 20 male participants per class. The class will be for no more than (2) two hours a week. The qualified instructor(s) will be required to provide an invoice at the end of each session. This invoice will be provided to the Program Coordinator and payment for services will be issued once submitted and approved.

Facilities and Equipment

The Escambia County Jail will provide the classroom and will enroll the students into each parenting session. The literature and classroom materials will be provided by the instructor and the Parenting program that is implemented; which includes, but not limited to writing utensils, paper, workbooks, text books, and etc.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide a schedule of sessions beginning October 1st, 2019 through September 30th, 2020
- Provide curriculum on teaching subject
- Maintain records of attendance, participation, and completion
- Provide a professional learning environment

Job Requirements

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in Social Work, Psychology, Education or an equivalent degree.
- Two or more years of experience in working with families
