This addendum becomes a part of the quote specifications and modifies the original specifications as noted.

ITEM NO. 1: Please see the attached specifications for the multipurpose training door.

END OF ADDENDUM NO. 1

The Multipurpose Training Door must:

1. Be designed for repeated mechanical and hydraulic breaching
2. Must be constructed of heavy grade steel
3. Must utilize a floating case design to allow for repeated jamb and case separation without destroying the door frame
4. The door must be able to replicate a wide range of entryway designs to include:
 - Outwards-opening and inwards-opening doors
 - Wooden doors, security doors, fire doors, etc.
 - Doors with a variety of locking points, locking mechanisms and overall resistance
5. Must have a minimum of six possible locking points for outward opening door training
6. Must have a minimum of six resistance levels for inward opening door training
7. Must have a replaceable ram impact surface for training on inward opening doors
8. Must be able to be used for security plate bypass training with replaceable jamb edges
9. Must allow for customizable breach team training
10. Must have consumable refills and replacement components available
 - Replaceable jamb edges
 - Replaceable ram impact surface
11. Must include A-frame and assembly hardware
12. Must include (1 unit) Replacement Door Edges
13. Must include (1 unit) Replacement Case Edges
14. Must include (25 pieces) Replacement Door Pins
15. Must include (25 pieces) Replacement Door Shims
16. Training Door dimensions must be:
 - Door Opening Height 84"
 - Door Opening Width 50"
 - Overall Depth 96"
17. Must be made in the USA
