Vendor will provide and install Llumar brand or approved equal, 35% window tint on forty (40) 2018 Dodge Chargers. Winning vendor shall be provided a list of approved vehicles, by city ID number.

- Vendor must have certified installers perform installation of tint.
- Vendor must have experience installing window tint on similar police vehicles.
- The applied tint shall be rated to reduce ultraviolet light and heat.
- Vendor shall prepare the window surfaces for the tint application and shall install the tint on the interior side of the window surface. Finished product must be free of bubbles.

Contractor will have the right to defend the City with counsel of its choice that is satisfactory to the City, and the City will provide reasonable cooperation in the defense as Contractor may request. Contractor will not consent to the entry of any judgment or enter into any settlement with respect to an indemnified claim without the prior written consent of the City, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld or delayed. The City shall have the right to participate in the defense against the indemnified claims with counsel of its choice at its own expense.

Contractor shall save, indemnify and hold City harmless and pay judgments that shall be rendered in any such actions, suits, claims or demands against City alleging liability referenced above.

The indemnification and hold harmless provisions of this Agreement shall survive termination of the Agreement.
