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BOATING RESTRICTED SIGNAGE QUINN BAYOU / BLACKWATER RIVER

Ref: See attached drawing for location of existing and proposed signage.

1. Removal, demolition & disposal of existing sign in old location.

2. Furnish and install 30'X8" MRT pile with (2) 4'X3' signs to read: <u>Idle Speed No Wake</u> (ISNW) for boaters going from Blackwater River into Quinn Bayou, and Resume Normal Safe Operation (RNSO) for boaters leaving Quinn Bayou going into Blackwater River. Contractor to supply all necessary materials and hardware and must comply with Florida Uniform Water Markers Guideline Requirements. *All work must be in compliance with the "Guidelines for Posting Uniform Waterway Markers in Florida's Waterways"*

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3. Timeline of when contractor can commence work following a Notice to Proceed:

City will require contractor to provide evidence of Commercial Liability Coverage, Worker's Compensation and Equipment insurance in the amount of \$1M, <u>with Longshore and Harbor</u> <u>Workers' Compensation endorsement</u> with city as Certificate holder and copies of contractor's license, as well as other city forms (Public Entity Crime Form, Drug Free Workplace, etc.)
