Trailer should 8x14 with 2 7000lb axles with electric brakes. Tires are to be load range E LT tires mounted on steel wheels. There should be an emergency trailer breakaway with battery mounted to the tongue. The tongue should be I- beam A-frame design with a single 2 stage crank/gear jack in the center. The trailer coupler should be able to be a pintle hitch design, or fitted with a 2 5/16 ball mount coupler that can be adjusted up and down by moving to different mounting holes and bolting it in place. Built into the A-frame of the tongue shall be storage box with a folding T-handle, locking latch. The trailer fenders should be painted steel bolt on fenders. All trailer wiring shall be LED and all wiring should be in mesh loom. NO SCOTCH LOCK connectors are to be used anywhere on the trailer. The Deck should be 2" Hardwood with 2 - 500 gallon double wall tanks, with internal baffles. Each tank is to be bolted thru the deck, to the frame of the trailer, with no less than 4- 5/8 grade 8 bolts. The tanks should be connected at the bottom with a 2" galvanized pipe, with 1/4 turn ball valves at either end. There will also be 1/4 turn ball valves at either opposite ends at the bottom. There should also be a large 4" hole with threaded plug in the top of the tanks. Both tanks should have proper venting and fill gauges. Connected to one tank should be a 2 stage air operated fluid transfer pump. This pump should be valved, so it can either pump oil out of a waste oil tank and into the tanks on the trailer, or by operating the valves, pump the oil out of the tanks on the trailer to a waste oil tank. The suction hose 1 1/2" 20 feet long and on a reel mounted on the right front corner of the trailer. Hose reel and pump should be accessed from the ground, without climbing onto the trailer. Everything should be painted black. No logos or decals of any kind should be on the trailers or tanks. The ID plate for the trailer should be made out of metal and VIN number either engraved or stamped into the plate.

INDEMNIFICATION CLAUSE

Contractor shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City, its officers, employees and agents from any and all liabilities which may accrue against the City, its officers, employees and agents or any third party for any and all lawsuits, claims, demands, losses or damages alleged to have arisen from an act or omission of Contractor in performance of this Agreement or from Contractor's failure to perform this Agreement using ordinary care and skill, except where such injury, damage, or loss was caused by the sole negligence of the City, its agents or employees.

Contractor shall save, indemnify and hold the City harmless from the cost of the defense of any claim, demand, suit or cause of action made or brought against the City alleging liability referenced above, including, but not limited to, costs, fees, attorney fees, and other expenses of any kind whatsoever arising in connection with the defense of the City; and Contractor shall assume and take over the defense of the City in any such claim, demand, suit, or cause of action upon written notice and demand for same by the City. Contractor will have the right to defend the City with counsel of its choice that is satisfactory to the City, and the City will provide reasonable cooperation in the defense as Contractor may request. Contractor will not consent to the entry of any judgment or enter into any settlement with respect to an indemnified claim without the prior written consent of the City, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld or delayed. The City shall have the right to participate in the defense against the indemnified claims with counsel of its choice at its own expense.

Contractor shall save, indemnify and hold City harmless and pay judgments that shall be rendered in any such actions, suits, claims or demands against City alleging liability referenced above.

The indemnification and hold harmless provisions of this Agreement shall survive termination of the Agreement.
