EXHIBIT 1 - STATEMENT OF WORK LIGHTING AT PUBLIC RECREATION AREAS AND BOAT RAMPS

I. INTRODUCTION BACKGROUND:

The St. Johns River Water Management District maintains water control structures and public recreation sites within the Blue Cypress Conservation Area and the Three Forks Marsh Conservation Area which are located in Indian River and Brevard Counties in the State of Florida. Parking areas and boat ramps provide access to District properties and recreational opportunities to the public 24 hours a day 7 days a week. Lighting these areas into the evening and again in pre-dawn hour is important for safe use of these areas.

II. OBJECTIVES:

The objective is to provide lighting to improve the safety and usefulness of parking areas and boat ramps.

III. SCOPE:

Contractor shall furnish all materials, labor, transportation including any necessary equipment to remove old lighting structures and install appropriate and operational lighting at the recreation sites listed below:

- 1. Tom Lawton Recreation Area: Remove three solar systems and light fixtures on existing poles, provide and install a new and complete solar system with LED light fixture capable of lighting the parking area for at least two hours after sunset and two hours before sunrise for each pole.
- 2. Blue Cypress Recreation Area: Remove existing solar system and light fixture on existing pole, provide and install a new and complete solar system with LED light fixture capable of lighting the parking area for at least two hours after sunset and two hours before sunrise.
- 3. Fellsmere Grade Recreation Area: Remove existing damaged fixtures, provide and install three new and complete lighting systems with LED area light fixtures with an appropriate brightness for the parking area.

NOTE: No hunting or fishing allowed on job site. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to contact the local County Animal Control and/or the Florida Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission for any problems with nuisance animals that may interfere with work at these sites.

IV. TASK IDENTIFICATION:

Contractor Responsibilities:

- Install appropriate and operational lighting at the recreational areas listed above
- Contractor shall consult with District's Project Manager for inspection and approval of work quality being accomplished before leaving the site. Contractor shall remove, replace or repair work that fails to meet the standards as set forth in this Statement of Work.
- Contractor is responsible for notifying the District's Project Manager not more than 96 hours and not less than 72-hours prior to initiating any work. This notification is necessary to arrange verification of completed work by District's inspection staff.

- Remove and properly dispose of all materials and trash generated from the work
- Perform a joint inspection with the District's Project Manager of each site
- Responsible for any damage that Contractor has caused to District property
- Demobilize from District property upon completion of the job

District Responsibilities:

- Provide maps for each location site
- Provide access by a key or temporary lock combination for access to the project field sites
- Perform a joint inspection with Contractor of each site prior to, and upon completion of work

V. TIMEFRAMES & DELVERABLES:

Contractor shall mobilize and initiate work within 14 days of execution of the Contract and shall be completed within 30 days.

Payment shall be made upon completion of work at all sites, and approval by the District Project Manager.


VII. DIRECTIONS:

Fellsmere Grade Recreation Area (Stick Marsh boat ramp). From Palm Bay or Fellsmere, Florida, take Babcock St. (CR 507) to Fellsmere Grade Road. Turn west on Fellsmere Grade Road, travel approximately six (6) miles to Blue Cypress Conservation Area.

Blue Cypress Recreation Area (512 Recreation Area boat ramp). Take Babcock Street (CR 507) south to (CR 512) turn right travel approximately eight (8) miles to 512 Recreation Area.

Tom Lawton Recreation Area. From Palm Bay, Florida, take Babcock Street (CR 507) to Malabar Road travel west eight (8) miles to Three Forks Marsh Conservation Area.



Blue Cypress Recreation Area "512"




On the west side of Hwy. 512, 1.5 miles north of Hwy 60 in Indian River County.

LETTER AGREEMENT INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Consultant shall acquire and maintain until completion of the Work the insurance coverage listed below, which constitutes primary coverage. Consultant shall not commence the Work until the District receives and approves Certificates of Insurance documenting required coverage. Consultant's General Liability policy shall name the St. Johns River Water Management District ("District") as Additional Insured. All required policies shall include: (1) endorsement that waives any right of subrogation against the District for any policy of insurance provided under this requirement or under any state or federal worker's compensation or employer's liability act; (2) endorsement to give the District no less than 30 days' notice in the event of cancellation or material change. Certificates of Insurance must be accompanied by copies of the requested endorsements.

Any deductibles or self-insured retentions above \$100,000 must be declared to and approved by the District. Approval will not be unreasonably withheld. Consultant is responsible for any deductible or self-insured retention. Insurance must be placed with insurers having an A.M. Best rating of A-V or greater. District receipt of insurance certificates providing less than the required coverage does not waive these insurance requirements.

- (a) Workers' Compensation Insurance. Workers' compensation and employer's liability coverage, including maritime workers' compensation, if applicable, in not less than the minimum limits required by Florida law. If Consultant claims an exemption from workers' compensation coverage, Consultant must provide a copy of the Certificate of Exemption from the Florida Division of Workers' Compensation for all officers or members of an LLC claiming exemption who will be participating in the Work. In addition, Consultant must provide a completed District "Affidavit (Non-Construction)" for non-construction contracts.
- (b) **General Liability.** Commercial General Liability Insurance on an "Occurrence Basis," with limits of liability not less than \$500,000 for personal injury, bodily injury, and property damage. Coverage shall include: (1) liability, (2) products and completed operations, (3) independent contractors, and (4) property in the care, control, or custody of Consultant. Extensions shall be added, or exclusions deleted to provide the necessary coverage.
- (c) Automobile Liability. Minimum requirements of Florida law.
