Project Scope and Specifications

The Bear Lake Migrant Head Start, 10101 Nurnberger Road, Bear Lake, Manistee County, MI 49614 is in need of re-roofing.

Building floor plan attached. Accurate measurements are the contractor's responsibility.

NOTE:

Due to roof leaks, one roof section was re-roofed November 2018: West side of the facility: 12 Sq. section Certainteed Landmark Pro Shingles, 6 ft. ice and water winter guard (waterproofing shingle underlayment), Certainteed Diamond Deck (high performance synthetic underlayment), possible Certainteed ridge vent or pop vent, Certainteed Swiftstart (starter shingle), shadow ridge (hip and ridge accessory shingles (Cap)), possible new pipe boot, and new drip.

- Re-roof all remaining areas: Match above shingles and other listed materials where needed.
- Contractor responsible for repair of any building damage as a result of the installation.
- Contractor to pay for costs of any required permits and application fees.
- Contractor will clean up and remove debris from site.
- Contractor shall make themselves aware of all site and building conditions related to work.
- Davis Bacon wage rates apply.

Budget

All proposals must include proposed costs to complete the tasks described in the project scope. Costs should be stated as an hourly rate. In-kind contribution should be identified and itemized.

IN-KIND CONTRIBUTION for Bear Lake Migrant Head Start Center: Re-roof.

The Administration for Children and Families (ACF) requires all Head Start grantees such as Telamon Corporation to provide contributions equal to 25 percent of their total Federal Head Start funding (or 20 percent of the total Federal and non-Federal combined). Telamon Corporation is asking for an in-kind contribution from the Contractor selected that might range from 2 percent to 10 percent of the base bid.

In-kind is defined as property or services that benefit a grant-supported project or program (such as the Head Start program) and are contributed by non-Federal third parties without charge to the grantee. In-kind contributions may consist of the value of real property and equipment and the value of goods and services directly benefiting the grant program and specifically identifiable to it.

Bidder Qualifications

Bidders must provide the following as part of their proposal for consideration:

- Three (3) references.
- Date when bidder is able to begin work and expected completion date.

Terms and Conditions

Telamon Corporation reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Telamon Corporation is an equal opportunity employer and service provider.

Evaluation Criteria

Telamon Corporation will evaluate all proposals based on the following criteria. To ensure consideration for the Request for Proposal, your proposal must be complete and include all of the following criteria:

- Overall proposal suitability: proposed work must meet the scope and needs included herein and be presented in a clear and organized manner.
- Organizational Experience: Bidders will be evaluated on their experience as it pertains to the scope of this project.

- Previous work: Bidders will be evaluated on examples of their work pertaining to the quality and completion timeliness of work.
- Value and cost: Bidders will be evaluated on the cost of work to be performed in accordance with the scope of this project and in the in-kind contribution.
- Experience: Bidders must provide descriptions of staff experience.

The contractor selected will be required to name **Telamon Corporation as an additional insured** on a Certificate of Insurance listing the policy numbers and amount of coverage for Works Compensation and General Liability Insurance. Certificates of Insurance must provide for a minimum requirement of \$1,000,000 in General Liability and State required minimums in Workers Compensation coverage.
