Bidders are expected to supply a top quality product, poorly built cabinets will not be accepted.

ADDITIONAL SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. Weather resistant cabinet coating similar to Scorpion brand or equal color black.
- 2. It is essential that the SCBA bracket have a safety strap that must be released to remove the SCBA to prevent the air pack from being removed or getting out of the bracket.
- 3. SCBA Bracket for use with 45 min cylinders.
- 4. No cabinet access from behind rear seats, only access shall be full depth access from rear.
- 5. Drawers must be latching, stay-closed type.
- 6. Cargo straps to hold items inside the two storage areas to be seat belt buckle type.
- 7. Ratcheting command board to be magnetic dry erase.



Drawing shows measurements to fit into the rear cargo area of 2019 Chevrolet PPV Tahoe. It shows the desired placement of SCBA bracket, drawer locations and storage areas.

It is understood that each manufacturer may differ slightly in measurements; however, the height of the cabinet and length requested must be exact due to the vehicle being used.

INDEMNIFICATION CLAUSE

Contractor shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City, its officers, employees and agents from any and all liabilities which may accrue against the City, its officers, employees and agents or any third party for any and all lawsuits, claims, demands, losses or damages alleged to have arisen from an act or omission of Contractor in performance of this Agreement or from Contractor's failure to perform this Agreement using ordinary care and skill, except where such injury, damage, or loss was caused by the sole negligence of the City, its agents or employees.

Contractor shall save, indemnify and hold the City harmless from the cost of the defense of any claim, demand, suit or cause of action made or brought against the City alleging liability referenced above, including, but not limited to, costs, fees, attorney fees, and other expenses of any kind whatsoever arising in connection with the defense of the City; and Contractor shall assume and take over the defense of the City in any such claim, demand, suit, or cause of action upon written notice and demand for same by the City. Contractor will have the right to defend the City with counsel of its choice that is satisfactory to the City, and the City will provide reasonable cooperation in the defense as Contractor may request. Contractor will not consent to the entry of any judgment or enter into any settlement with respect to an indemnified claim without the prior written consent of the City, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld or delayed. The City shall have the right to participate in the defense against the indemnified claims with counsel of its choice at its own expense.

Contractor shall save, indemnify and hold City harmless and pay judgments that shall be rendered in any such actions, suits, claims or demands against City alleging liability referenced above.

The indemnification and hold harmless provisions of this Agreement shall survive termination of the Agreement.
