SCOPE OF WORK

FOR

PORTABLE TOILET, SEPTIC AND LEACHATE PUMPING AND CLEANOUT SERVICES

Pricing shall be effective 10/1/2019 through 9/30/2020

Vendor to provide portable toilets and cleanout, septic cleanout and leachate pumping services to the Waste Services department. All septic liquids to be disposed of properly at the local waste treatment facility. Vendor to provide 2-hour emergency response time if needed.

Additionally, portable toilet service shall be provided for the Regional Round Up events at a variety of locations throughout the county.

Perdido Landfill

13009 Beulah Rd., Cantonment, FL

Provide seven portable toilets with hand sanitizer and one hand washing station to be placed around the landfill as instructed. Units require cleaning twice weekly, Tuesday and Friday.

Household Hazardous Waste Building: As needed pump out service of the 100-gallon capacity wash water holding tank.

Leachate lift stations require a vacuum truck with at least 25 feet of suction hose. All vacuum trucks that will perform leachate pumping service must be empty upon arrival at the site. Leachate will be transported to the on-site holding ponds.

Palafox Transfer Station

2906 N. Palafox Street, Pensacola, FL

Provide two portable toilets with hand sanitizer to be placed as instructed. Units require cleaning twice weekly, Tuesday and Friday.

At minimum, a quarterly maintenance tank pump out service is required for the 1,000-gallon capacity lift station and the 1,000-gallon capacity oil/water separator. A minimum 25' hose is required to perform the cleanout service at this location.

Oak Grove

745 N. Highway 99, Oak Grove, FL

Provide two portable toilets with hand sanitizer to be placed as instructed. Units require cleaning once per week. This location is open Friday and Saturday only. Units shall be cleaned after Saturday but before Friday of the following week.

Regional Round Up Events

Provide two portable toilets with hand sanitizer to be placed at the designated location. This is a onehalf day event held on a Saturday. Delivery is preferred Saturday morning no later than 7:00 a.m. Pick up is preferred by 12:30 p.m. as locations are locked and access will not be available. Waste Services currently holds five events per year. The number of events is subject to change.
