Background

The City of Georgetown (City) is an incorporated municipality with a population of nearly 10,000 residents. The City is located 60 miles north of Charleston and 36 miles south of Myrtle Beach. It is the end point of the area commonly known as "The Grand Strand". The City is bordered by the Winyah Bay to the east and the Sampit River to the south. Tourism is a major economic driver in the area, as well as local industries, such as International Paper and Tidelands Hospital. The City is the county seat and operates under the Mayor-Council form of government as set forth in the State of South Carolina Code Chapter II, Article I, Section 2-1. The original City Hall building located at 120 N. Fraser Street, Georgetown, SC, was constructed in 1977. The building foundation became unstable during the US 17/City Hall Drainage Project in 2011, after a dewatering process took place. The existing City Hall building was deemed unsafe and uninhabitable in August 2016. The building is currently under demolition. The City intends to rebuild a new City Hall on the same site. Petroleum odors have been noticed during previous soil borings.

Scope of Services

The City of Georgetown is seeking proposals from qualified environmental consultant firms to conduct a Limited Phase II Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) at the old City Hall building site located at 120 N. Fraser Street, Georgetown, SC. The purpose of the Limited Phase II ESA is to evaluate potential soil, groundwater and soil vapor contamination associated with the site.

The assessment shall be conducted in accordance with industry approved standards and in general accordance with ASTM E1903-11 Standard Practice for Environmental Site Assessment: Phase II Environmental Site Assessment Process excluding monitoring wells.

The Consultant will be responsible to conduct the Limited ESA by collecting soil and groundwater samples from the old building site to determine if any form of contaminated substances are present or likely present. Three (3) representatives sample locations must be selected. Samples shall be collected from separate test pit locations as identified by the City. Excavation of test pits will be performed by others. See Exhibit A-Area Map.

Samples shall be tested for PCBs, VOCs, SVOCs, and RCRA Metals and preliminary results should be submitted to the City within 7 days of testing.

Consulting firm shall report findings to the City in an expeditious manner and verify or rule out the presence of contaminants. Consultant's report must include an interpretation of results, recommendations, conclusions, and a remedial plan of action (if applicable). Final report must be submitted to the City within 4 weeks of site sampling and collection.

When the Purchasing Department is closed due to force majeure, bid and proposal openings will be postponed to the same time on the next official business day.

The City reserves the right to cancel or reissue the RFQ and/or revise the project schedule at any time.

The City also reserves the right to reject any or all proposals as deemed to be in its best interest, and to accept all or part of the scope of work herein as its project timeline and/or budget allows.

All information will be updated and posted on the City's website <u>www.cogsc.com</u> under "Bids". It is the firm's responsibility to obtain the information directly from the City's website regarding this project.

- 3. Report preparation

Insurance and Business License Requirements

The selected firm will be required to provide proof of insurance with a minimum amount of \$1,000,000 as follows:

- Comprehensive General Liability (per occurrence);
- Comprehensive Auto Liability (per occurrence); and
- Workers' Compensation Liability
- Professional Liability

The City of Georgetown is to be named as "Additional Insured" on the above insurance coverage as respect to the City's interest under the consultant's agreement. Certificate of insurance shall be submitted to the City prior to commencement of services.
