This Task Order is issued pursuant to the agreement for Information Technology Services dated November 11, 2023, between Okaloosa County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the “OWNER”, and Security Engineering of Pensacola, a Florida corporation, hereinafter referred to as the “CONSULTANT”.

PURPOSE

The primary purpose of this Task Order is to authorize and direct the CONSULTANT to proceed with necessary Information Technology Services for the OWNER. Furthermore, it serves as a mechanism for defining the obligations of the parties within the agreement. Such obligations can be further delineated in “Scope of Services”.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The CONSULTANT agrees to provide security-related products and installation services to the OWNER, in accordance with the provisions of contract C24-3921-IT. An estimate for the job is included as part of this Task Order, detailing the scope, labor, and materials required. Services may include, but are not limited to:

- Installation of access control boards, power supplies, card readers, electric locking hardware, door contacts, recorders, and camera systems
- Preventative maintenance, fiber optic connections, storage solutions, and consultation/design services
- Troubleshooting, testing, and repairing security systems

All services and products (including hardware and software) related to these categories may be purchased by the OWNER from the CONSULTANT with or without merchandise discounts.

COMPENSATION PROVISIONS

As compensation for the services outlined in this Task Order, the OWNER will pay CONSULTANT according to Section 4 of the November 11th agreement. Payments will be based on the CONSULTANT'S contracted rates and fees for the actual time worked on the mutually agreed-upon project. A written estimate should be provided for all work, excluding routine maintenance agreed upon in advance. The CONSULTANT's invoice must include the contract number, task order number, and remaining task order balance. Each item should be priced individually with the quantity specified. The OWNER will pay the CONSULTANT within 30 days of receiving a proper invoice, subject to the satisfactory completion of the mutually agreed-upon project.

The not-to-exceed amount for this Task Order is \$41,038.41.
