This First Amendment to the Agreement between Okaloosa County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (the "County"), and Pictometry International Corp. ("Contractor"), executed this 11th day of April, 2025, is made a part of the original Agreement dated January 7, 2025, Contract No. C25-4088-IT (the "original Agreement"), incorporated herein by reference. The County and Contractor hereby agree as follows:

1. **AMENDMENT.** The County and Contractor wish to amend the original Agreement as follows:

All references to "The Pictometry International, Inc." in the Agreement shall be replaced with "Pictometry International Corp.". This clarification of the entity name shall not affect the rights, obligations, or performance of the parties under this Agreement.

2. **OTHER PROVISIONS REMAIN IN EFFECT.** Except as specifically modified herein, all terms and conditions of the original Agreement between the parties, dated January 1, 2025 and any amendments thereto, shall remain in full force and effect.

3. **CONFLICTING PROVISIONS.** The terms, statements, requirements, or provisions contained in this Amendment shall prevail and be given superior effect and priority over any conflicting or inconsistent terms, statements, requirements or provisions contained in any other document or attachment.
