This Amendment Number 2 is made on the date of execution by the County and amends Agreement Number 21-DHS-RFP-598c ("Main Agreement") dated December 1, 2021, between Job Discovery, Inc. ("Contractor") and the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia ("County").

- 2. PURSUANT TO CLAUSE 4: CONTRACT TERM, THIS AGREEMENT IS HEREBY RENEWED FROM DECEMBER 1, 2023 TO NOVEMBER 30, 2024.
- 3. PURSUANT TO CLAUSE 6. CONTRACT PRCE ADJUSTMENTS, THE CONTRACT PRICE IS HERBY INCREASED BY 3.7% FOR THE 12 MONTH PERIOD ENDING NOVEMBER 30, 2024.
- 4. REPLACE EXHIBIT B IN ITS ENTIRETY WITH THE ATTACHED.
- 5. REMOVE CLAUSE 21 COVID-19 VACCINATION POLICY FOR CONTRATCTORS IN ITS ENTIRETY.
- 6. REMOVE EXHIBIT D CONTRACTOR COVID-19 VACCINATION CERTIFICATION.
- 7. REMOVE EXHIBIT E CONTRACTOR COVID-19 VACCINATION QUARTERLY COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATION.
