**AGREEMENT NO. 19-090-R
AMENDMENT NUMBER 2**

This Amendment Number 2 is made on the date of execution by the County and amends Agreement Number 19-090-R (“Main Agreement”) dated February 21, 2019 between **National Elevator Inspection Services, Inc.** (“Contractor”) and the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia (“County”).

16. ADD THE PARAGRAPH 22. COVID-19 VACCINATION POLICY FOR CONTRACTORS AS FOLLOWS:

22. COVID-19 VACCINATION POLICY FOR CONTRACTORS

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the County has taken various steps to protect the welfare, health, safety and comfort of the workforce and public at large. As part of these steps, the County has implemented various requirements with respect to health and safety including policies with respect to social distancing, the use of face-coverings and vaccine mandates. All County Contractors, entering County owned, controlled, or leased facilities or facilities operated by a contractor if the services provided at that location are exclusive to Arlington County Government or contractors with public facing responsibilities must adopt these policies for implementation with their employees and subcontractors working on County contracts.

Contractors are required to obtain and maintain the COVID-19 vaccine status of employees or subcontractors, require any unvaccinated or not fully vaccinated employees to follow a weekly testing protocol established by the Contractor to submit to weekly testing, and provide any accommodations as required by law. Contractor should submit the certification of compliance to the Purchasing Agent at the time of contract execution and within five working days of the end of each quarter (see Exhibits B and C). In addition, all Contractor and subcontractor employees subject to the requirements of this section must also comply with the County COVID-19 masking and social distancing protocols, as signed at each County location.

It is recognized that the COVID-19 pandemic is an ongoing health crisis. As such, requirements with respect to health and safety, including vaccines and face-coverings may change over time. Contractors are expected to adhere to the County requirements as they evolve in response to the crisis.

CONTRACT AMENDMENT #2

This Agreement constitutes an amendment to Contract RFQ 687 for Elevator Inspection and Plan Review Services between the **COUNTY OF LOUDOUN, VIRGINIA** (County) and **BUREAU VERITAS NATIONAL ELEVATOR INSPECTION SERVICES, INC. successor in interest to NATIONAL ELEVATOR INSPECTION SERVICES, INC.** (Contractor) (collectively, the parties).

In consideration of the mutual covenants set forth herein, the parties agree to amend and modify the Contract effective December 1, 2021 as follows:

2.2 Term

The Contract will be renewed for the period of December 1, 2021 through November 30, 2023. There are two (2) additional two (2) year renewal periods remaining on this Contract.

2.21 Assignment

Pursuant to Contract No. RFQ 687, Section 2.21 Assignment, this Contract is assigned from National Elevator Inspection Services, Inc. to Bureau Veritas National Elevator Inspection Services, Inc.

Bureau Veritas National Elevator Inspection Services, Inc. shall assume all rights and responsibilities under Contract No. RFQ 687 and any amendments thereto. See Exhibit 1, Bureau Veritas National Elevator Inspection Services, Inc. Notice of Name Change letter dated October 8, 2021 and Exhibit 2, Purchasing Agent's Acceptance of Assignment Letter dated October 26, 2021, each attached and incorporated herein.

3.0 **COMPENSATION**

Compensation shall be per the attached and incorporated **REVISED** Attachment #1 Pricing, dated December 1, 2021. This includes a three-percent (3%) increase on all line items based on the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W), unadjusted for seasonal changes, for this period. This attachment replaces the pricing on Attachment #1 Pricing, dated December 1, 2017.

In all respects not specifically mentioned or altered by Amendment, the original Contract shall remain in full force and effect.


