## **RESOLUTION NO. 19-65**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING CONTRACT #W1162 WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR SUPERVISED INMATE LABOR SERVICES IN THE ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$57,497 COMMENCING MAY 1, 2019 AND ENDING ON APRIL 30, 2020 WITH AN OPTION TO RENEW FOR THREE ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR TERMS UNDER THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXERCISE THE RENEWAL OPTION ON THE CITY'S BEHALF AND EXPEND FUNDS FOR THE SERVICES, SUBJECT TO BUDGETING AND APPROPRIATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, under Section 30-57, City Code, the City is authorized to acquire services from other governmental entities without the necessity of competitive bidding by the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of Florida Department of Corrections ("DOC") form Contract #W1162, DOC is willing to provide the City the services of a work crew of up to eight laborers, plus one supervisor, for grounds maintenance at a cost of \$57,497 per year, for a term commencing May 1, 2019 and ending April 30, 2020 with options to renew for three additional one-year terms under the same terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, the City's cost of hiring personnel to provide such services in-house would be approximately \$284,678.50 per year; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director recommends the acquisition of the supervised inmate labor services from DOC, because of the opportunity to save substantial costs for the required grounds maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Contract #W1162 with the Florida Department of Corrections ("DOC"), for supervised inmate labor services for an annual amount of \$57,497, commencing May 1, 2019 and ending on April 30, 2020 with an option to renew for three additional one-year terms under the same terms and conditions, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute Contract #W1162 with DOC, a copy of the Contract in substantially final form being attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

SECTION 3. It is found that the expenditure provided for in Section 1 above is from a governmental entity, pursuant to Section 30-57, City Code, and is in the best interest of the City.

SECTION 4. The City Manager is authorized to exercise the option to renew Contract #W1162 with DOC on behalf of the City and expend funds for the services, subject to budgeting and appropriation.

## SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
