

RESOLUTION NO. 18-79

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE LOW BID OF YELLOWSTONE LANDSCAPE-SOUTHEAST, LLC, TO PROVIDE LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE SERVICES ON BEVILLE ROAD FOR A TERM OF THREE YEARS, WITH OPTIONS TO RENEW FOR TWO ONE-YEAR TERMS, AT A TOTAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$98,885.00 ANNUALLY; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE CONTRACT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXERCISE THE CITY'S OPTIONS TO RENEW, SUBJECT TO BUDGETING AND APPROPRIATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, bids for the Landscape Maintenance Contract project were duly called for and advertised; and

WHEREAS, all bids received were opened on January 9, 2018, and are listed on the Bid Tabulation attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Public Works Director recommends acceptance of the bid submitted by Yellowstone Landscape-Southeast, LLC, and the Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission finds that the lowest and best bid submitted by a responsive bidder is the following:


SECTION 2. The aforesaid bid is hereby accepted subject to the terms and conditions of the bid documents.

SECTION 4. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to return the bid security of all unsuccessful bidders in accordance with the terms of the bid documents.


SECTION 5. The City Manager is authorized to exercise the City's options to renew the above-referenced Contract, subject to budgeting and appropriation.
