## AGREEMENT NO. 21-DHS-RFP-598b AMENDMENT NUMBER 5

This Amendment Number 5 is made on  $\frac{3/25/2024}{}$  and amends Agreement Number 21-DHS-RFP-598b ("Main Agreement") dated December 1, 2021, between ServiceSource, Inc. ("Contractor") and the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia ("County").

The County and the Contractor agree to amend the Main Agreement as follows:

1. Replace Exhibit B in its entirety with the attached Revised Exhibit B, Contract Pricing As Of April 1, 2024. Program Enhancement pricing will be increased by \$7,552.08 per month to \$19,635.41. The new yearly total for Program Enhancement will be \$205,416.61.
