**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
OKALOOSA COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY  
AND  
FORT WALTON BEACH MEDICAL CENTER**

This agreement is entered into by and between **OKALOOSA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES** and **FORT WALTON BEACH MEDICAL CENTER**, Fort Walton Beach, Florida, and is effective May 22, 2008.

The parties acknowledge and agree to the following:

Upon request by Ft. Walton Beach Medical Center, Okaloosa County EMS will pick up Ft. Walton Beach Medical Center Staff and equipment to provide transportation of a neonatal patient back to the Ft. Walton Beach Medical Center.

In consideration of this, Ft. Walton Beach Medical Center will supply such staff and equipment at no cost to the County.

Further, Ft. Walton Beach Medical Center understands that Okaloosa County EMS will be the only party billing the patient for transport services.

At all times while Fort Walton Beach Medical Center employees are providing patient care during the transports, Fort Walton Beach Medical Center shall maintain professional liability insurance covering employees with at least limits of one million dollars \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$3,000,000 aggregate per policy year against any claims arising from any act or omission of any act by their employees providing medical care. Certificate of such insurance shall be provided to the County upon request.

At all times while Fort Walton Beach Medical Center employees are providing patient care during the transports, Fort Walton Beach Medical Center shall maintain Florida Workers compensation insurance at statutory limits and accidental medical, death and dismemberment insurance for employees with limits of at least \$15,000.00 for accidental medical expenses, and limits of at least \$25,000.00 for accidental death or dismemberment. Certificate of such insurance shall be provided to the County upon request.


