## **Engineering & Environmental Services Agreement**

Santa Rosa County ("County") and Geosyntec Consultants, ("Contractor") enter into this agreement this \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, 2020.

- A. This Agreement is for the provision of Consulting Engineering Services for the Santa Rosa County Environmental Division and shall be as follows:
  - 1. Contractor will be required to provide services as described in the Request for Oualifications, Engineering and Environmental Services, attached as "Exhibit A".
  - 2. All services performed by the contractor and its personnel shall be performed to the satisfaction of Santa Rosa County Environmental Division.
  - 3. The term of this contract will be for three (3) years with the option to renew at the end of the first contract period for an additional three (3) period upon agreement of both parties.
  - 4. The County will issue a Specific Scope of Work requesting engineering and environmental services as needed.
  - 5. Payment shall be made as set forth in the Contractor's fee schedule attached as "Exhibit B" based on fixed hourly cost for all positions required to complete the requested services, however the Santa Rosa Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to award contracts based on a lump sump bid and make payments based on the percentage of work completed.
  - 6. Santa Rosa County reserves the right to enter into contracts for engineering, environmental or other professional services with any firm, under contract or not, at the discretion of the Board of County Commissioners, deemed to be in the best interest of Santa Rosa County.
  - 7. Santa Rosa County may terminate this agreement without cause upon giving seven (7) days written notice. Contractor will be paid for all work performed prior to termination.
  - 8. Contractor shall have and maintain the required insurance as specified in the attached "Exhibit C" and shall provide Santa Rosa County proof of such insurance prior to commencing work.

9. Contractor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless County, its agents, officials and employees for any and all claims, suites and damages to the extent arising out of the negligent operation of this contract.
