## AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR MARINE LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

## CONTRACT # C22-3252-TDD

**2023** This Amendment No. 3 hereby amends the Interlocal Agreement effective October 1, <del>2022,</del> by and between Okaloosa County, Florida ("County") and Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office ("Sheriff"), for Marine Law Enforcement Services ("Contract"), also known as County Contract No. C22-3252-TDD. MEVERIN BLL REARK

COUNTY

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Section 6 of the Contract allows annual amendments to Exhibit A outlining fiscal year scope and funding; and

WHEREAS, both parties desire to amend the Contract to reflect scope and funding for the fiscal year October 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein and other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereby agree to amend the Contract as follows:

(stricken words indicate deletions, <u>underlined</u> words indicate additions)

- Section 3. County's Responsibilities shall be amended as follows: <u>"...</u>not to exceed <u>SIX\_HUNDRED\_THIRTY\_SIX\_THOUNSAND\_FIVE\_HUNDRED</u> <u>DOLLARS (\$636,500.00) for services rendered for the fiscal year October 1, 2022 to</u> <u>September 30, 2023</u> as set forth in EXHIBIT A."
- Section 3. County's Responsibilities shall be amended as follows: "The Sheriff is authorized to shift expenses between line items so long as the total annual amount is not exceeded. <u>Failure to provide the requisite documentation for payment by</u> October 31 shall result in forfeiture of County funds."
- 3. Exhibit A shall be amended as included herein.
- 4. This Amendment No. 3 shall be effective October 1, 2023.
- 5. All other provisions of Contract # C22-3252-TDD shall remain in full force.

Two Deputy Sheriff/Marine Units and two Deputy Sheriff/Beach Patrol/Beach Safety Units provide public safety, crime prevention, water rescue and recovery, evacuation from all hazards, as any other activities that require enforcement. Areas of coverage include all beaches and waterways. Deputy Sheriff's are the only enforcement entity for county ordinances. Overtime coverage is for the White Point Road, Spring Break details, park safety, and neccessary public safety needs surrounding the beaches and waterways as needed to provide additional enforcement in the tourist districts. When required the personnel assigned to these details will conduct physical arrests for violations of Fiorida Statutes and prisoner transports. We will endeavor to build a coalition with Destin Fire Control District and Beach Safety to co-locate resources on each vessel to enable an allhazards response to emergencies around Crab Island.

**STATEMENT OF ISSUE:** Request approval of the Sheriff's annual TDD public safety funding, via amendment 3 changing attachment A, to the interlocal agreement (C22-3252-TDD) with the Okaloosa Sheriff's Office for funding in the amount of \$695,983 for FY 2024 marine law enforcement services.

**BACKGROUND:** Ten percent of collections from the first five pennies are budgeted for public safety in the following manner for FY 2024:

Public safety reserves are the accumulation of unspent funds within the 10% cap from prior years available for use in the event of a current year shortfall or unanticipated needs.
