

**ARLINGTON COUNTY, VIRGINIA  
AGREEMENT NO. 17-316-EP  
AMENDMENT NUMBER 5**

This Amendment Number 5 is made on the DATE and amends Agreement Number 17-316-EP (“Main Agreement”) dated September 17, 2017, between L’Arche of Greater Washington (“Contractor”) and the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia (“County”).

The County and the Contractor agree to amend the Main Agreement as follows:

**1. ADD THE FOLLOWING TO PARAGRAPH 5. CONTRACT AMOUNT, FOR FY22 WITH THE FOLLOWING:**

**5. CONTRACT AMOUNT**

For FY2022, the County is increasing the maximum allowable amount by **\$5,000** to a total **\$95,240.00**, to cover staffing cost for an emergency hospital stay through the Group Home Emergency fund.

- Companion Care services shall be reimbursed at the current DMAS DD Waiver Companion Care rate (currently \$18.02 per hour); up to a maximum of \$5,000.00 for costs incurred for staffing individuals needing support when hospitalized and billing Medicaid Waiver is not an option. Billing is allowable with prior authorization from the residential coordinator, along with documentation of date, hours and name of staff who provided the support.

**3. ADD PARAGRAPH 54. COVID-19 VACCINATION POLICY FOR CONTRACTORS AS FOLLOWS:**

**54. COVID-19 VACCINATION POLICY FOR CONTRACTORS**

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the County has taken various steps to protect the welfare, health, safety and comfort of the workforce and public at large. As part of these steps, the County has implemented various requirements with respect to health and safety including policies with respect to social distancing, the use of face-coverings and vaccine mandates. All County Contractors, entering County owned, controlled, or leased facilities or facilities operated by a contractor if the services provided at that location are exclusive to Arlington County Government or contractors with public facing responsibilities must adopt these policies for implementation with their employees and subcontractors working on County contracts.

Contractors are required to obtain and maintain the COVID-19 vaccine status of employees or subcontractors, require any unvaccinated or not fully vaccinated employees to follow a weekly testing protocol established by the Contractor to submit to weekly testing, and provide any accommodations as required by law. Contractor should submit the certification of compliance to the Purchasing Agent at the time of contract execution and within five working days of the end of each quarter (see Exhibits D and E). In addition, all Contractor and subcontractor employees subject to the requirements of this section must also comply with the County COVID-19 masking and social distancing protocols, as signed at each County location.

It is recognized that the COVID-19 pandemic is an ongoing health crisis. As such, requirements with respect to health and safety, including vaccines and face-coverings may change over time. Contractors are expected to adhere to the County requirements as they evolve in response to the crisis.

**ATTACHMENT B- Revised**

**Contract Pricing**

Starting on July 1, 2022, the County will pay the Contractor in accordance with the terms of the Payment section below and up to a maximum of \$95,240.00 per year for services delivered to eight (8) Arlington County clients at two group homes. The Contractor shall bill Medicaid through Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) for services provided to individuals with DD Medicaid Waiver funding. The maximum amount of \$95,240.00 will be paid as follows:

- A maximum of \$61,440.00 per year to cover expenses not reimbursed by Medicaid Waiver funding.
- A maximum of \$28,800.00 per year for housing assistance.
- In the event one or more of the eight (8) Arlington County individuals experiences a medical emergency that requires hospitalization and billing Medicaid waiver is not an option, the Contractor, with prior approval from the County Project officer, may provide Companion Care to the resident in the medical facility. The number of companion care hours will be determined on a case-by-case basis. This service shall be reimbursed at the current DD Waiver Companion Care rate, currently \$18.02 per hour up to a maximum of \$5,000.00.

Clients are to pay no more than 30% of their income on housing and this must be reflected in their residential fee agreement. The Contractor shall provide to the Project Officer a copy of the current residential fee agreement for each Client prior to submitting any bill for housing assistance.

The County will reduce payment on a monthly basis for discharged or attritioned clients at a rate of \$940.00 per month per client.

Arlington County funds must be used in adherence to all Federal and Commonwealth of Virginia, Department of Medical Assistance Services regulations governing DD Home and Community-Based Medicaid Waiver Services.
