

**ARLINGTON COUNTY, VIRGINIA
AGREEMENT NO. 21-DHS-EP-598b
AMENDMENT NUMBER 2**

This Amendment Number 2 is made on 11/30/2022 by the County and amends Agreement Number 21-DHS-EP-598b ("Main Agreement") dated December 1, 2021, between Service Source, Inc. ("Contractor") and the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia ("County").

The County and the Contractor agree to amend the main contract called for under the Main Agreement as follows:

1. **PURSUANT TO THE PROVISION 4 CONTRACT TERM, THIS AGREEMENT IS HEREBY RENEWED FROM DECEMBER 1, 2022, TO NOVEMBER 30, 2023. THIS IS THE FIRST OF FOUR (4) RENEWAL OPTIONS AVAILABLE WITH THREE (3) ONE (1) YEAR RENEWALS REMAINING.**

2. **PURSUANT TO CONTRACT CLAUSE 6. CONTRACT PRICE ADJUSTMENTS, THE CONTRACT PRICE IS HEREBY INCREASED BY 7.5% CPI-U INCREASE, NOT TO BE CHANGED BETWEEN DECEMBER 1, 2022, AND NOVEMBER 30, 2023 AS SET FORTH IN CONTRACT CLAUSE 6.**

3. **EXHIBIT B IS HEREBY REPLACED IN ITS ENTIRETY WITH THE ATTACHED REVISED EXHIBIT B.**

All other terms and conditions of the Main Agreement remain in effect.

Group Day Support – Structured program provided in groups of no more than one (1) staff member to seven (7) participants. The program must provide opportunities for peer interactions, community integration, career planning, and enhancement of social networks. This service helps to mitigate the risks that participants may face from social isolation. The staff member must be always within arm’s reach of the assigned participants due to the complex behavioral or medical support needs that constitute the basis for one-to-one staff support. This service will be time limited, and a plan to reduce or fade the service should be discussed and developed at the start of the services.
