A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE LOW BID OF PROLIME CORPORATION PROVIDING FOR TRANSPORT AND DISPOSAL OF LIME SLUDGE AT A RATE OF \$13.43 PER WET TON FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$350,000 FOR A THREE-YEAR PERIOD; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND UP TO \$350,000 FOR FY 2014-2015 AND AS NEEDED FOR EACH ADDITIONAL YEAR OF SERVICE SUBJECT TO BUDGETING AND APPROPRIATIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
