





Summary/Highlights:				
The county offers free resident drop off recycling services at the Tomoka landfill and the DeLand transfer station, including obsolete electronic devices. The county received four bids for the transportation and recycling of these devices shown on the attached tabulation sheet. Staff recommends a multiple award to the two lowest responsive and responsible vendors: Southeastern Data, Longwood, FL, primary vendor; and A1 Assets, Inc., Longwood, FL, secondary vendor, for an initial three year award with two subsequent one year renewals upon county council approval. A multiple award will help ensure the availability of services when needed. Estimated annual expenditures are approximately \$50,000.00.
