

8.G. Police Department - Rossmeyer Daytona Motorcycles Inc., D/B/A Bruce Rossmeyer's Daytona Harley-Davidson - Police Motorcycle Lease (pp. 101-111)

Resolution approving a lease agreement with Rossmeyer Daytona Motorcycles Inc., D/B/A Bruce Rossmeyer's Daytona Harley-Davidson, 1637 North US Highway 1, Ormond Beach, FL 32174, for the lease of fifteen (15) new 2019 FLHP motorcycles, with a unique police package from Bruce Rossmeyer's Daytona Harley-Davidson, from 10/01/18 through 09/30/24; at a rate of \$8,250 monthly (\$99,000 annually). The lease includes an upgrade every two years for a new motorcycle including a two year warranty. It is requested that the City Commission waive the competitive selection requirements as provided in Section 30-58 of the Purchasing Code. Bruce Rossmeyer's Daytona Harley-Davidson provided a lower rate than BMW, the only other company in the area that has a Police Motorcycle Package. The package includes an option to ensure that the motorcycles have a full warranty for the entirety of the lease and includes installing and transferring of police emergency equipment. Funds available in the General Fund.

8.H. Police Department - Enterprise Leasing Company of Orlando, LLC - Unmarked Vehicle Lease (pp.112-154)

Resolution authorizing the rental of ten (10) unmarked vehicles for the SIU undercover unit from Enterprise Leasing Company of Orlando, LLC (Enterprise) 5442 Hoffner Avenue, Orlando, FL 32812. Volusia County Sheriff's Office has a Preferred Rate Agreement for July 17, 2014 to September 30, 2017, plus one (1) extension bringing the expiration date through September 29, 2018. The Daytona Beach Police Department wishes to "piggy back" off the Volusia County Preferred Rate Agreement, commencing April 1, 2018 and terminating on or before the expiration date according to the needs of the Department. The total cost for the contract is not to exceed \$76,000.00 annually at a rate of \$609 monthly per vehicle, which includes coverage of all maintenance. Upon Commission approval of the proposed FY 2017/2018 budget, funds will be available in both the Federal Shared Property Forfeiture Fund and the Police Dept. General Fund.

DATE: March 9, 2018

The Police Department is requesting authorization to lease fifteen (15) new motorcycles at a rate of \$550.00 per month, per motorcycle, which includes customary maintenance as per factory recommendation from Bruce Rossmeyer's Daytona Harley-Davidson, 1637 North US Highway 1, Ormond Beach, FL 32174. I am requesting that the City Commission waive the competitive selection requirements as provided in Section 30-58 of the Purchasing Code. The term of this lease is for seventy-two (72) months commencing October 1, 2018 and ending on September 30, 2024.

The Police Department has previously leased police motorcycles from the Victory Police Motorcycle Company at Volusia Motorsports, 1701 SR 44, New Smyrna Beach, FL 32168. As of January 1, 2017 production of the Victory Motorcycles has been discontinued by the manufacturer. The existing Victory Police contract expires on September 30, 2018. With the expiration coming, we have investigated the only other vendors in the area who could offer a Police Motorcycle package for a new lease term, Harley Davidson and BMW Motorcycles.

The BMW Motorcycle Company offered a comparable motorcycle to the Harley Davidson. The lease would include fifteen (15) motorcycles at a rate of \$850.00 per motorcycle, per month for a length of five (5) years. The price of this lease does not include service. The warranty is listed at three (3) years, which would leave the city liable for all damage and maintenance for the last two (2) years.

The offer from Bruce Rossmeyer's Harley Davidson, is a lease of seventy-two (72) months at \$550 per month, per motorcycle. During the term of this lease, Lessor will deliver 2019 model year motorcycles on October 1, 2018, 2021 model year motorcycles on October 1, 2020, and 2023 model year motorcycles on October 1, 2022. Lessor will be responsible for installing the police emergency equipment on the initial 2019 model year motorcycle and transferring it to the 2021 and 2023 model year motorcycles. Each cycle of motorcycles will be covered by a two (2) year warranty.

The Police Department has leased motorcycles from Bruce Rossmeyer's Daytona Harley-Davidson for several years and we have found their terms to be acceptable to the nature of motorcycle leasing for the traffic unit.

Police Legal Advisor Anthony Jackson has reviewed this resolution request and has signed the Agenda Summary.

MOTORCYCLE LEASE AGREEMENT

This Motorcycle Lease Agreement (the "Lease") is made this 1st day of June 2017 by and between Rossmeyer Daytona Motorcycles Inc., DBA Bruce Rossmeyer's Daytona Harley-Davidson, 1637 North US Highway 1, Ormond Beach, FL 32174, ("Dealer" or "Lessor") and the City of Daytona Beach, (the "Department" or "Lessee"), whose address is 129 Valor Blvd, Daytona Beach, FL 32114 for the lease of police motorcycles (hereinafter referred to as "the vehicles") as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, for use by the Department's authorized employees in the performance of police-related or law-enforcement duties. The terms and conditions of the Lease are as follows:

1. **Term:** The term of this Lease shall be seventy-two (72) months commencing on October 1, 2018 and ending on September 30, 2024. During the term of this lease Lessor will deliver 2019 model year motorcycles October 1, 2018, 2021 model year motorcycles October 1, 2020, and 2023 model year motorcycles October 1, 2022. Lessor will be responsible for installing the police emergency equipment on the initial 2019 model year motorcycle and transferring it to the 2021 model year motorcycle and then to the 2023 model year motorcycle.
2. **Payment:** Lessee shall pay Lessor \$550.00 for each vehicle commencing October 1, 2018 which includes police emergency equipment as listed in Exhibit A. At the end of the term (6yrs) the police emergency equipment becomes the property of the City of Daytona Beach Police Department.
3. **Miscellaneous Fees:** Lessor agrees to pay for all official fees in connection with the certificate of title, registration and license fees and any applicable taxes for each of the leased vehicles. Lessor agrees to waive all charges with respect to freight and dealer prep of the vehicles.
4. **Maintenance, Repairs and Operating Expenses:** Lessee is responsible for and agrees to pay for all maintenance and repairs to keep the vehicles in good working order and condition and other expenses associated with operating the vehicles. Lessee agrees to service the vehicles at Bruce Rossmeyer's Daytona Harley-Davidson, 1637 North US Highway 1, Ormond Beach, FL 32174 according to the manufacturer's recommendations as outlined in the owner's manual for the vehicles and as requested by the manufacturer in any recall campaign.

5. **Use and Subleasing:** Lessee agrees that the vehicles (a) will be operated only by authorized licensed drivers employed by Lessee as law-enforcement officers; (b) will be kept free of all fines, liens and encumbrances; (c) will not be used illegally, improperly, for hire, or contrary to the manufacturer's recommendations; and (d) will not be altered, marked or have equipment installed on them without Lessor's consent.

6. **Insurance:** During the term of the Lease, Lessee must maintain public liability and physical damage insurance on the vehicles that covers both Lessee and Lessor. Lessee agrees that the Lessee's own liability insurance will provide primary insurance coverage up to its full policy limits. Lessor must be named as "additional insured" and "loss payee" on Lessee's insurance policy. As an alternative, Lessee may provide proof to Lessor that it is self-insured. Lessee's insurance policy must provide that Lessor will be notified in writing at least 10 days before the insurance is cancelled or coverage altered and that Lessor, or its representatives, may have full access to any claim file in the event of an insurable loss. In the event of a total loss or destruction of vehicles, Lessee's maximum exposure shall be the Lessor's cost of the vehicle as shown on its books/records.

Lessor shall provide the Lessee with evidence of insurance as follows: Workers Compensation, General Liability, Automobile Liability, and Errors and Omissions (Professional) Liability if required.

Lessor's insurance shall apply only when the vehicles are in Lessor's care, custody or control.

7. **Notice of Accidents and Cooperation:** Lessee agrees to cooperate fully with Lessor and any insurance company in the investigation and defense of any and all claims arising from their possession and use of the vehicles. Lessee will make a complete report to Lessor within 48 hours after any accident, theft or loss involving the vehicles.

8. **Indemnification:** To the extent permitted by law, the Lessee agrees to indemnify and hold Lessor, its affiliates, assignees, officers, agents and employees harmless from all losses, liability, damages, injuries, and claims, arising out of the use of vehicles while in the care, custody or control of the Lessee, arising from the negligence or accident of the Lessee, its employees, officers, and agents.

The Lessee shall not be liable for injuries or damages resulting from product defects or dealer negligence, which includes, but is not, limited to the maintenance and repair of the motorcycles. Lessor agrees to indemnify, defend, and save harmless the Lessee, its employees, agents, and City Commission against liability arising from any claim, cause of action, or lawsuit brought against the Lessee, its employees, agents and the City Commission as a result of negligence on the part of the Lessor, its employees and agents.

9. **Limitation of Liability:** Lessor shall not be liable for any indirect or consequential damages or inconvenience (except for those relating to personal injury) which may result to Lessee from any damages to, or defect in, the vehicles for the time needed to repair or service the vehicles. Monthly lease payments shall continue and not be reduced or delayed during this time. Lessor makes no express warranties covering the vehicles. In particular, Lessor makes no express warranties of vehicle condition, merchantability, durability or fitness for a particular purpose of use covering the vehicle, and Lessor expressly disclaims any such express warranties. Harley-Davidson Motor Company does warranty the vehicles for two years with unlimited mileage.

10. **Return of the Vehicles:** At the end of the Lease, the Lessee must return the vehicles to Lessor in good condition, without damage, excessive wear or use and with all the original equipment installed by the manufacturer.

- Vendor will not be responsible for accident or training damage
- Tank, fenders, and saddlebags will be free of dents
- Chrome edges of floor boards shall not be completely worn down
- Clutch and brake levers shall not be bent
- Windshields shall be free of scratches and distortion
- Tires must have a minimum of 4/32 tread depth
- Police decals must be removed prior to return if required
- Service must be up to date as per factory recommendation
