## **RESOLUTION NO. 12-329**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH HALIFAX HOSPITAL MEDICAL CENTER, SOLE SOURCE PROVIDER, FOR MEDICAL SERVICES FOR A ONE-YEAR PERIOD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000 WITH TEN ONE-YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 30-55, City Code, provides for purchases from sole source vendors without competitive selection; and

WHEREAS, the City has used the services provided by the EmployMed program of Halifax Hospital Medical Center for approximately fifteen years for drug screenings of new hires, random screening and testing of current employees, and police and fire post-offer physicals; and

WHEREAS, staff has researched the local area for the services and found EmployMed to be the sole provider of all the services required by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Risk Manager recommends entering into an agreement with Halifax Hospital Medical Center for EmployMed medical services for a one-year period in the amount not to exceed \$30,000 with ten one-year options to renew; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The Agreement for Provision of EmployMed Services with

Halifax Hospital Medical Center providing for drug screenings, police and fire post-offer

physicals, and various other medical services in an annual amount not to exceed \$30,000 is

hereby approved. A copy of the Agreement in substantially final form is attached hereto and

made a part hereof by reference.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the

above-referenced Agreement.

SECTION 3. It is found that the expenditure provided for in Section 1 above is

made pursuant to Section 30-55, City Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
