Pruning/weeding of flowers/groundcover/shrubs/ornamental grasses shall occur with each mow.		
Deep pruning shall be performed once a year during the dormant months to maintain proper proportions, promote interior growth, and an aesthetically pleasing appearance (once plants begin to "shatter" or fall apart, approximately January). Removal of up to 50% of the height and foliage of plants shall take place. All ornamental grasses shall be pruned to an approximate 12 to 18-inch height removing previous year's growth and drying and declining foliage.
