**AGREEMENT NO. 20-102-R
AMENDMENT NUMBER 1**

This **Amendment Number 1** is made on the date of execution by the County and amends Agreement Number **20-102-R** ("Main Agreement") dated March 1, 2020 between **Avia Partners, Inc.** ("Contractor") and the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia ("County").

The County and the Contractor agree to amend the main contract called for under the Main Agreement as follows:

1. ADD THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE TO SECTION 2. CONTRACT TERM:

Upon satisfactory performance by the Contractor, if Brazoria County renews their agreement identified in Exhibit A, the County may elect to renew this Agreement under the same contract terms for two (2) one-year renewal periods from October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2022 ("Subsequent Contract Term"). However, if the Brazoria County does NOT renew their agreement identified in Exhibit A, this Agreement shall automatically expire on the date of the contract expiration.




All other terms and conditions of the Main Agreement remain in effect.

Once the form is completed online, the system will issue a certificate number. Please print, sign the form, and email it to Amy Krodel at amyk@brazoria-county.com.


In addition, completion of the Conflict of Interest Questionnaire, Form CIQ, is required if applicable. Texas Local Government code 176 requires that any person who seeks to enter into a contract with a local government entity (including any agent of such person or vendor) disclose in Form CIQ the vendor or person's employment affiliation, business relationship, family relationship or provision of gifts that might cause a conflict of interest. You may access the form and further information on our website at <http://brazoriacountytx.gov/departments/purchasing> under the Doing Business section; Conflict of Interest Reporting.

The Texas Local Government Code Section 1, Subtitle F, Title 10, Chapter 2270 states that a governmental entity may not enter into a contract with vendors under certain circumstances for goods or services unless the contract contains a written verification from the vendor that it: 1) does not boycott Israel; and 2) will not boycott Israel during the term of the contract. Sign and return the attached Verification Form, if applicable.
