1. Introduction/Background

Arlington County Commuter Services (ACCS) encourages the implementation of transportation demand management (TDM) initiatives in the County by promoting public knowledge and use of commuting alternatives to the single occupant vehicle (SOV). These initiatives encourage the use of alternatives to SOV use via promotional efforts and information intended to achieve the following benefits:

- A. Reductions in the demand for parking space and related traffic congestion in transit development corridors;
- B. Maximum efficient utilization of existing public and private transit systems and HOV infrastructure;
- C. Enhancement of the County as a business location;
- D. Improvements in air quality and reductions in the consumption of nonrenewable fuels;
- E. Increased mobility for the elderly, disabled, low-income residents and persons not conveniently or adequately served by conventional transportation services.

ACCS accomplishes its mission by encouraging people who live, work or commute through Arlington to use mass transit, car and vanpool, bicycle, walk, carshare, telecommute, and use other alternatives to driving alone. ACCS encourages alternative commuting through the following programs and services:

- The Commuter Store[™] with locations in Ballston, Rosslyn, Crystal City and Shiriington. Also includes operations of two Mobile Commuter Stores;
- Arlington Transportation Partners Employer and Residential Services;
- Web Sites and Mobile Tools CommuterPage.com[®], CommuterDirect.com[®], ArlingtonTransit.com, WalkArlington.com, BikeArlington.com, CarFreeDiet.com, ArlingtonTransportationPartners.com, CarFreeNearMe, Point-to-Point.

Marketing programs include:

 Arlington Transit - ART – marketing, advertising and promotions of the Arlington Transit bus service. Also includes Arlington STAR paratransit services and the iRide program for teens.

ACCS is a bureau within the Department of Environmental Services, Division of Transportation.

3. <u>Scope</u>

The contractor will provide services related to the ongoing Arlington Transit - ART outreach program based on the tasks listed below.

4. Tasks

A. Outreach Services

Provide all services related to planning, securing and staffing for transit related events to be held in Arlington County including:

- Coordinate event logistics.
- Train and provide information to staff on the outreach topic. Training to be held in NeoNiche or County offices as determined by the Project Officer.
- Promote Arlington Transit, Metrobus, iRide and Car-Free Diet to event participants.
- Order and store brochures as needed from ACCS Distribution Center.
- At the direction of the Project Officer, the Contractor shall provide support in the form of 2person or more, depending on the event, "outreach teams" to serve as extensions of the Arlington Transit team enabling program visibility in the community. In some cases, the outreach teams would be the only program representatives at a small community event, popular community location or school. In other cases, the outreach teams would be supplementary staff at events that are also staffed by Arlington Transit team members. The Contractor shall only staff events as approved by the Project Officer.
- Attend an average of five (5) events a month; no more than 60 a year. Number of events a
 month may vary depending on season and outreach needs. Staff time at an event may vary
 from a minimum of 4 hours to a maximum of 9.5 hours. All events, purchases and activities
 must be approved by the Project Officer.

B. Brochure Distribution for iRide Klosks

Provide all services related to upkeep of iRide kiosk displays in Arlington middle and high schools. All schools are located in Arlington County. Services include:

- Refill approximately 13 iRide kiosks with iRide, ART, Car-Free Diet, Bike Maps, Walkabout, and other ACCS brochures on a quarterly basis. Maintain the kiosks and report any damage to them.
- Install updated kiosk panels on an as needed basis, no more than 1 time a year.

C. Design Marketing Materials

Design marketing materials to promote Arlington Transit as needed at the direction of the Project Officer, Services include:

- Develop marketing materials such as, but not limited to, filers, posters, brochures, videos and social media posts to promote Arlington Transit. The Contractor will work with the Project Officer on the design and content of the materials to make sure it targets the intended audience. - Provide final print or product files to the Project Officer.

- Promotional materials listed in section "4C" above as needed.

6. Place of Performance

• All events shall take place in Arlington, Virginia, as approved by the Project Officer.

7. Period of Performance

• This Task Order shall cover the period from its date of execution to June 30, 2021.

• Contractor shall inform the ACCS Project Officer when they have reached 75% of the Not-to-Exceed Amount of the Task Order.
