**AGREEMENT NO. 18-074-R
AMENDMENT NUMBER 5**

This Amendment Number 5 is made on the date of execution by the County and amends Agreement Number 18-074-R (“Main Agreement”) dated February 15, 2008 between Computing Systems Innovations (“Contractor”) and the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia (“County”).

The County and the Contractor agree to amend the main contract called for under the Main Agreement as follows:

- **2. CONTRACT TERM** (pg. 1)
Contract renewal from June 1, 2021 to May 31, 2022. Upon satisfactory performance by the Contractor, and with the concurrence of the Contractor, if the Supreme Court of Virginia renews their agreement identified in Attachment A, the County may elect to renew this Agreement for an additional one year period under the same contract unit prices for not more than (1) additional twelve (12) month period from June 1, 2022 to May 31, 2023 (“Subsequent Contract Term”). However, if the Supreme Court of Virginia does NOT renew their agreement identified in Attachment A, this Agreement shall automatically expire on the date of the Supreme Court of Virginia’s contract expiration date.




