## ARLINGTON COUNTY, VIRGINIA AGREEMENT NO. 230-11-EP AMENDMENT NUMBER 14

This Amendment Number 14 dated June 11, 2020 is made by the County and amends the original Agreement Number 230-11 ("Main Agreement") dated June 16, 2011 between Doorways for Women and Families ("Contractor") and the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia ("County").

The County and the Contractor agree to amend the Main Agreement as follows:

## 1. The Limiting English Proficiency Clause is hereby revised or added.

Limited English Proficiency - The Contractor must comply with Executive Order 13166, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and make reasonable efforts to ensure that as part of the services that it provides, adequate communication services, including interpretation and translation, are available to persons who have limited English proficiency. If such services are not included in the Contract's scope of services and pricing, the Contractor will use a County-contracted service provider, and the County will make arrangements with a County-contracted service provider and pay the fees.

## 2. Contract Term

The new contract term will start on July 1, 2020 and work is to be completed no later than June 30, 2021.

## 3. Amend Exhibit A. Scope of Work, Section IV. Services by Contractor as follows:

In accordance with the Limited English Proficiency Clause, the Contractor must have policies and procedures in place to implement the services including staff training. Policies must be made available upon request.

DOORWAYS FOR WOMEN AND CHILDREN

All other terms and conditions of the Main Agreement remain in effect.
