

RESOLUTION NO. 19-33

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF THE JONES COMPANY OF SOUTH FLORIDA, TO PROVIDE AS-NEEDED EARTHWORK, GRADING AND GRASSING CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR CITY PROPERTIES AND RIGHTS OF WAY FOR A TWO-YEAR TERM, WITH OPTIONS TO RENEW THREE ONE-YEAR TERMS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE A TERM CONSTRUCTION SERVICES CONTRACT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXERCISE THE CITY'S RENEWAL OPTIONS IN FUTURE FISCAL YEARS, SUBJECT TO BUDGETING AND APPROPRIATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, bids for as-needed earthwork, grading, and grassing construction services were duly called for and advertised; and

WHEREAS, bid opening was on August 16, 2018, the Bid Tabulation being attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bidder, Faith Construction Inc., has withdrawn their bid and forfeited their 10% bid security; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Public Works Director recommends acceptance of the second lowest bid submitted by The Jones Company of South Florida and the Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission finds that the lowest and best bid submitted by a responsive bidder is the following:

SECTION 3. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Term Construction Services Contract, with the Jones Company of South Florida, in accordance with the bid documents.

SECTION 4. The City Manager is authorized to exercise the City's options to renew the above-referenced Contract, and to expend funds for as-needed earthwork, grading and grassing services in future fiscal years subject to budgeting and appropriation.

SECTION 5. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to return the bid security of all unsuccessful bidders in accordance with the terms of the bid documents.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
