

RESOLUTION NO. 15-270

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE LOW BID OF P & S PAVING, INC., FOR AS-NEEDED STREET MILLING AND RESURFACING SERVICES FOR A TERM OF ONE YEAR WITH TWO ONE-YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$557,548 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXERCISE THE OPTIONS TO RENEW AND MAKE SUCH EXPENDITURES DURING RENEWAL TERMS AS ARE BUDGETED AND APPROPRIATED; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, bids for as-needed Street Milling and Resurfacing services were duly called for and advertised; and

WHEREAS, all bids received were opened on September 22, 2015, and are listed on the Bid Tabulation attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and Public Works Director recommend acceptance of the bid submitted by P & S Paving, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate in the amount of \$557,548 for services under the contact during fiscal year 2015-2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission finds that the lowest and best bid submitted by a responsible bidder for as-needed Street Milling and Resurfacing services is from P & S Paving, Inc., 3701 Olson Drive, Daytona Beach, FL 32124, for a period of one year with two one-year options to renew (ITB No. 0115-2650).


SECTION 2. The aforesaid bid is hereby accepted subject to the terms and conditions of the bid documents. The total expenditure for as-needed Street Milling and Resurfacing services for FY 2015-2016 shall not exceed \$557,548.

SECTION 3. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an appropriate contract or such documents as may be required.


SECTION 4. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to return the bid security of all unsuccessful bidders in accordance with the terms of the bid documents.

SECTION 5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to exercise the options to renew the contract with P & S Paving, Inc., for as-needed Street Milling and Resurfacing services and make such expenditures during renewal terms as are budgeted and appropriated.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
