**AGREEMENT NO. 19-006-ITB  
AMENDMENT NUMBER 01**

This **Amendment Number 01** is made on **April 2, 2021** and amends Agreement Number **19-006-ITB** (“Main Agreement”) dated **June 26, 2019** between **Buckingham Car Wash, LB dba Mr. Wash Carwash #8** (“Contractor”) and the **County Board of Arlington County, Virginia** (“County”).

The County and the Contractor agree to amend the main contract called for under the Main Agreement as follows:

**1. UPDATE THE SPECIFICATIONS REFERENCED IN PARAGRAH 2, SCOPE OF WORK TO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:**

During the COVID-19 Pandemic, all interior cleaning services shall be halted. The Project Officer will provide notice in writing no less than fourteen (14) Calendar Days when interior cleaning services will resume.

**2. UPDATE THE BID PRICING OF CONTRACTOR TO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING LINE ITEM:**

**3. REPLACE THE AUDIT PARAGRAPH 35 IN ITS ENTIRETY WITH THE FOLLOWING:**

The Contractor must retain all books, records and other documents related to this Contract for at least five years, or such period of time required by the County’s funding partner(s), if any, whichever is greater, after the final payment and must allow the County or its authorized agents to examine the documents during this period and during the Contract Term. The Contractor must provide any requested documents to the County for examination within 15 days of the request, at the Contractor’s expense. Should the County’s examination reveal any overcharging by the Contractor, the Contractor must, within 30 days of County’s request, reimburse the County for the overcharges and for the reasonable costs of the County’s examination, including, but not limited to, the services of external audit firm and attorney’s fees; or the County may deduct the overcharges and examination costs from any amount that the County owes to the Contractor. If the Contractor wishes to destroy or dispose of any records related to this Contract (including confidential records to which the County does not have ready access) within five years after the final payment, or such period of time required by the County’s funding partner(s), if any, whichever is greater, the Contractor must give the County at least 30 days’ notice and must not dispose of the documents if the County objects.

The Purchasing Agent may require the Contractor to demonstrate that it has the necessary facilities, ability, and financial resources to comply with the Contract and furnish the service, material or goods specified herein in a satisfactory manner at any time during the term of this Contract.

All other terms and conditions of the Main Agreement remain in effect.


