

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-293

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE LOW BID OF YELLOWSTONE LANDSCAPE-SOUTHEAST, LLC FOR THE CITY'S MUNICIPAL STADIUM LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE AND MOWING SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$99,928 ANNUALLY FOR A THREE-YEAR TERM WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR AN ADDITIONAL TWO ONE-YEAR TERMS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$99,928 ANNUALLY FOR THE REMAINING YEARS OF THE CONTRACT SUBJECT TO BUDGETING AND APPROPRIATION; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS AND RETURN OF THE BID SECURITY OF ALL UNSUCCESSFUL BIDDERS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, bids were duly called for and advertised for landscape maintenance and mowing services for the Municipal Stadium; and

WHEREAS, bid opening was on June 29, 2020; the Bid Tabulation being attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director recommends that the City accept the bid submitted by Yellowstone Landscape-Southeast, LLC and the Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission finds that the lowest and best bid submitted by a responsive bidder is the following:


SECTION 2. The bid approved in Section 1 above is hereby accepted subject to the terms and conditions of the bid documents.


