AGREEMENT NO. 20-067-R AMENDMENT NUMBER 1

This Amendment Number 1 is made on the date of execution by the County and amends Agreement Number 20-067-R ("Main Agreement") dated November 7, 2019 between Splash Business Intelligence, Inc. ("Contractor") and the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia ("County").

The County and the Contractor agree to amend the Main Agreement as follows:

1. REVISE AND REPLACE PARAGRAPH 2. CONTRACT TERM AS FOLLOWS:

The Contractor's provision of goods and services for the County ("Work") shall commence upon the execution of the Agreement by the County" and shall be completed no later than March 28, 2029 ("Contract Term"), subject to any modifications as provided for in the Contract Documents regarding the Contract Term. No aspect of the Work shall be deemed complete until it is accepted by the County's Project Officer.

Upon satisfactory performance by the Contractor, if the U.S. General Services Administration Federal Acquisition Service renews their agreement identified in Exhibit A, the County may elect to renew this Agreement under the same contract terms. However, if U.S. General Services Administration Federal Acquisition Service does NOT renew their agreement identified in Exhibit A, this Agreement shall automatically expire on the contract expiration date.

All other terms and conditions of the Main Agreement remain in effect.
