

CONTRACT**DINWIDDIE COUNTY**
PROPANE

The Agreement is made this 25th day of August 2022, by and between **Parker Oil Company, Inc.**, of 14287 West Danville Street, South Hill, Virginia 23970 (party of the first part, and hereinafter known as “Contractor”), and the **County of Dinwiddie, Virginia** and the **Dinwiddie County School Board** (parties of the second part, and hereinafter known as “County”).

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Virginia Public Procurement Act, County solicited proposals to provide propane deliveries to Dinwiddie County Government and Schools; and

WHEREAS, Contractor submitted the sole proposal for same, consistent with the specifications in the Request for Proposals; and

WHEREAS, Contractor was selected as having the best offer; and

WHEREAS, County has selected Contractor to provide goods/services;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefits, promises, and undertakings, the sufficiency and receipt of which are acknowledged, the following terms and conditions are agreed to by the parties to this Contract:

1. **Incorporation by Reference.** The following are made a part hereof as if the same were fully set forth herein, and if any discrepancies arise between the documents, they will prevail in the following order: (1) this Contract (2) Request for Proposals # 22-053122 including any addenda and (3) Contractor’s proposal dated June 22, 2022. This procurement is governed by the Virginia Public Procurement Act and the Dinwiddie County Purchasing Policies and Procedures. All terms and conditions of the Act and the Policies and Procedures are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference herein.
2. **Time of Performance.** Contractor recognizes that services under this contract are vital to the County and must continue without interruption. Tank monitors will be installed and tanks are to be serviced on an automatic basis and fuels are to be resupplied when the tank levels reach approximately thirty percent (30%) capacity unless otherwise directed by the County.
3. **Term of Contract.** The term of this contract shall be for one (1) year beginning September 25, 2022 with the option for renewals under the terms, conditions and unit pricing of the original contract for up to four (4) additional years, unless either party gives written notification to the other party sixty (60) days prior to expiration of the then-current term that they do not wish to renew. The contract and any renewals are subject to the availability of funds and annual appropriations by the Board of Supervisors.
4. **Costs.** Contractor agrees to perform all work and provide all products pursuant to this Contract for the following prices (the “Contract Price”).

Other Fees

Repairs – During Business Hours*	\$155.00 per hour
Repairs – After hours, weekends, and holidays*	\$160.00 per hour
Materials – Percentage Discount Off Manufacturer’s List Price	10%
Emergency Service Fee for Unscheduled Deliveries	\$200.00

*Fees apply to County-owned tanks only.

There will be no adjustment to the differential for the first two years of the contract. Price increases thereafter, if any, shall not exceed the percentage increase/decrease of the ALL ITEMS category of the CPI-U Section of the Consumer Price Index of the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics for the latest twelve months for which statistics are available. Increases may also be negotiated at time of renewal.

Payment shall be made to Contractor by check within thirty (30) days after receipt of invoice.

- 6. **General Terms and Conditions.** During the term of this Contract, Contractor agrees to procure and maintain insurance which meets all County’s requirements in the Request for Proposals.
- 7. **Additional Users/Cooperative Procurement.** Per the provisions of Section 2.2-4304 of the Virginia Public Procurement Act (VPPA), “Cooperative Procurement”, if authorized by the Contractor, this contract may be extended to any jurisdiction/public body within the Commonwealth of Virginia to purchase at contract prices in accordance with contract terms. It is the Contractor’s responsibility to notify the jurisdiction/public bodies of the availability of contract(s).
- 8. **Counterparts.** This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts each of which shall be deemed an original but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Signed signature pages may be transmitted by facsimile or as an attachment to an email, and any such signature shall have the same legal effect as an original.
- 9. **Severability.** If any provision of this Agreement is determined to be unenforceable, invalid or illegal, then the enforceability, validity and legality of the remaining provisions will not in any way be affected or impaired, and such provision will be deemed to be restated to reflect the original intentions of the parties as nearly as possible in accordance with applicable law.
- 10. **Force Majeure.** Neither party hereto shall be held liable for delay or failure to perform hereunder, when such delay or failure is without its fault or negligence and due solely to events

beyond its control which cannot reasonably be forecast or provided against such as fires, strikes, floods, hurricanes, tornadoes, snowstorms, acts of God, acts of war or terrorism, or legal acts of public authorities.

- 11. **Miscellaneous.** This Contract shall be governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia. Jurisdiction and venue for any litigation arising out of or involving this Agreement shall lie in the Circuit Court of the County of Dinwiddie, Virginia, and such litigation shall be brought only in such courts. All pronouns used herein shall refer to every gender. Headings or titles in this Contract are only for convenience and shall have no meaning or effect upon the interpretation of the provisions of this Contract. This Contract is the entire agreement between the parties and may not be amended or modified, except by writing, signed by each party. If any provision of this Contract is determined to be unenforceable, then the remaining provisions of this Contract shall be interpreted as in effect as if such unenforceable provision were not included therein.

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ELECTRONIC RECORD AND SIGNATURE DISCLOSURE

From time to time, Dinwiddie County (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures. Described below are the terms and conditions for providing to you such notices and disclosures electronically through the DocuSign system. Please read the information below carefully and thoroughly, and if you can access this information electronically to your satisfaction and agree to this Electronic Record and Signature Disclosure (ERSD), please confirm your agreement by selecting the check-box next to 'I agree to use electronic records and signatures' before clicking 'CONTINUE' within the DocuSign system.

Getting paper copies

At any time, you may request from us a paper copy of any record provided or made available electronically to you by us. You will have the ability to download and print documents we send to you through the DocuSign system during and immediately after the signing session and, if you elect to create a DocuSign account, you may access the documents for a limited period of time (usually 30 days) after such documents are first sent to you. After such time, if you wish for us to send you paper copies of any such documents from our office to you, you will be charged a \$0.00 per-page fee. You may request delivery of such paper copies from us by following the procedure described below.

Withdrawing your consent

If you decide to receive notices and disclosures from us electronically, you may at any time change your mind and tell us that thereafter you want to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format. Consequences of changing your mind

Further, you will no longer be able to use the DocuSign system to receive required notices and consents electronically from us or to sign electronically documents from us.

All notices and disclosures will be sent to you electronically

Unless you tell us otherwise in accordance with the procedures described herein, we will provide electronically to you through the DocuSign system all required notices, disclosures, authorizations, acknowledgements, and other documents that are required to be provided or made available to you during the course of our relationship with you.
