THIS TASK ORDER IS ISSUED PURSUANT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES DATED MAY 7, 2019 AND CONTRACT RENEWAL DATED MAY 7, 2022, BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF OKALOOSA, FLORIDA, AND GULF COAST UNDERGROUND, LLC. AS WELL AS THE ARPA AGREEMENT NO. SLT0786 BETWEEN OKALOOSA COUNTY AND THE U.S. TREASURY, WHICH IS INCORPORATED HEREIN BY THIS REFERENCE.

Scope of Task Order (#11) Services for Gravity Sewer Rehab Maintenance Contract

Article A. Purpose:

The purpose of this Task Order is to authorize and direct CONTRACTOR (Gulf Coast Underground) to proceed with construction services for assisting the Okaloosa County Water and Sewer Department (COUNTY) to rehabilitate gravity sewer infrastructure. All work completed under this task order involving the American Rescue Plan Act, Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, shall comply with the County's grant agreement with the U.S. Treasury agreement No. SLT-0786. The activities that are included are described in "Article B. Scope of Services."

Article B. Scope of Services:

The professional construction services that CONTRACTOR agrees to furnish additional services for the rehabilitation of gravity sewer infrastructure primarily in the Oddfellow, Greenacres, Ocean City and Wright service areas (included in attached Scope of Work) to include CIPP lining, manhole lining, wet well lining, lateral lining, traffic control, bypass pumping, and any other related services covered in the referenced agreement.

Article C. Compensation Provisions:

As compensation for providing the services described within this Task Order, COUNTY shall pay CONTRACTOR in accordance with Contract Renewal (dated May 7, 2022) and the May 7, 2019 Agreement, based on the CONTRACTOR's Bid Item Schedule (Items 1-155), as adjusted in the Contract Renewal for the actual items performed/installed on the Project. The budget ceiling for this Task Order is \$1,925,000.00

The COUNTY shall pay the CONTRACTOR in installments calculated based upon the items of work completed as agreed upon by the COUNTY and CONTRACTOR and submitted on the CONTRACTOR'S Invoice/Pay Estimate Report.

Article D. Period of Service:



FY 2023 GCUC Task Order #11 (\$1,925,000)

Oddfellow Area, Fort Walton Beach – The remaining 14,385 feet
 (2.7 miles) of 8" VC gravity sewer pipe previously inspected in FY
 2022 will be lined with cured in place piping. In addition, 4,400
 feet of 8" pipe will be cleaned, inspected and lined in one of
 OCWS' older sewer service areas in a low-lying marshy area.



 Harris LS Area (north of Racetrack Rd.) — All remaining sections of 8" vitrified clay gravity sewer pipe to be cleaned, inspected and lined with cured in place piping in the area that backs up to the Bayou in this older, low lying neighborhood. Approximately 9,000 linear feet of piping to be rehabilitated in this area.



 Green Acres, Fort Walton Beach – Remaining sections of 8" and 10" vitrified clay pipe gravity sewer to be cleaned, inspected and lined with cured in place piping to complete rehabilitation of this low-lying marshy area of the system. Approximately 10,000 linear feet of piping to be rehabilitated in this area.



Ocean City, Fort Walton Beach – additional sections of 8" and 10" vitrified clay pipe gravity sewer to be cleaned, inspected and lined with cured in place piping in one of OCWS' oldest sewer service areas. This portion of work extends from the previously cleaned, inspected and lined sewer piping around the Clifford Lift Station. Approximately 17,000 linear feet of piping to be rehabilitated in this area. In addition, all remaining unlined manholes at the Clifford Lift Station will be rehabilitated during this fiscal year.
