

RESOLUTION NO. 18-315

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE LOW BID OF VETERAN 1 LAWN CARE, LLC, FOR LOT CLEARING AND NUISANCE ABATEMENT SERVICES FOR A THREE-YEAR TERM WITH OPTIONS TO RENEW FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR TERMS IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$83,090.00; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXERCISE THE CITY'S OPTIONS TO RENEW, SUBJECT TO BUDGETING AND APPROPRIATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, bids for Lot Clearance and Nuisance Abatement services were duly called for and advertised;

WHEREAS, all bids received were opened on August 15, 2018, and are listed on the Bid Tabulation attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Public Works Director recommends acceptance of the bid, submitted by Veteran 1 Lawn Care, LLC, and the Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission finds that the lowest and best bid submitted by a responsive bidder is the following:

SECTION 2. The aforesaid bid is hereby accepted subject to the terms and conditions of the bid documents.

SECTION 3. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the General Services Contract with Veteran 1 Lawn Care, LLC, in accordance with the bid documents.


SECTION 4. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to return the bid security of all unsuccessful bidders in accordance with the terms of the bid documents.

SECTION 5. The City Manager is authorized to exercise the City's options to renew the above-referenced Contract, subject to budgeting and appropriation.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
