ARLINGTON COUNTY, VIRGINIA AGREEMENT NO. 20-049-ITB AMENDMENT NUMBER 3

This Amendment Number 3 ("Amendment") is made on <u>7/26/2022</u>, and amends <u>Agreement</u> <u>Number 20-049-ITB</u> dated October 23, 2019 ("Main Agreement") and made between <u>MXI Environmental</u> <u>Services LLC, 26319 Old Trail Road, Abingdon, VA 24210</u> ("Contractor") and the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia ("County").

Whereas the County and the Contractor desire to amend the Contract Terms and Conditions under the Main Agreement, the Contractor and the County, in consideration of the promises and other good and valuable consideration specified in this Amendment, amend the Main Agreement as follows:

- 1. **Contract Renewal:** Pursuant to 4. Contract Term, the contract is hereby renewed for an additional 12-month period beginning November 1, 2022 (third subsequent contract term) with one (1) additional 12-month period remaining.
- Contract Price Increase: Pursuant to 6. Contract Pricing with Optional Price Adjustment (as amended below), the contract amount/unit price(s) is hereby increased by 8.6% of change in the U. S. Department of Labor Consumer Price Index, All Items, Unadjusted, Urban Areas ("CPI-U") for the 12month period ending in May 2022.
- 3. Contract Pricing With Optional Price Adjustments is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

6. CONTRACT PRICING WITH OPTIONAL PRICE ADJUSTMENTS

The Contract Amount/unit price(s) will remain firm until October 31, 2022 ("Price Adjustment Date"). To request a price adjustment, the Contractor or the County must submit a written request to the other party not less than 60 days before the Price Adjustment Date. Adjustments to the Contract Amount/unit price(s) will not exceed the percentage of change in the U.S. Department of Labor Consumer Price Index, All Items, Unadjusted, Urban Areas ("CPI-U") for the 12 months of statistics available at the time of the Contract's renewal.

Any Contract Amount/unit price(s) that result from this provision will become effective the day after the Price Adjustment Date and will be binding for 12 months. The new Price Adjustment Date will be 12 months after the price adjustment.

If the Contractor and the County have not agreed on a requested adjustment by 30 days before the Price Adjustment Date, the County may not renew the Contract, whether or not the County has previously elected to renew the Contract's term.

4. Force Majeure is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

37. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither party will be held responsible for failure to perform the duties and responsibilities imposed by this Contract if such failure is due to a fire, riot, rebellion, natural disaster, war, act of terrorism or act of God that is beyond the control of the party and that makes performance impossible or illegal, unless otherwise specified in the Contract, provided that the affected party gives notice to the other party as soon as practicable after the force majeure event, including reasonable detail and the expected duration of the event's effect on the party.

All other terms and conditions of the Main Agreement, as amended shall remain in full force and effect.
