FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGR. OKALOOSA COUNTY AND MV TRANSPORTATION, INC. FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES CONTRACT NO. C19-2761-TS

This Fourth Amendment (this "<u>Amendment</u>") to Agreement between Okaloosa County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("<u>County</u>"), and MV Transportation, Inc., a Foreign Profit Corporation ("<u>Contractor</u>") is made and entered into as of November <u>7</u>th, 2023 (the "<u>Effective Date</u>"). County and Contractor may hereinafter be referred to collectively as the "<u>Parties</u>" and individually as a "<u>Party</u>."

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Parties have entered into that certain Agreement, dated December 18, 2018, Contract No. C19-2761-TS (as amended, the "<u>Agreement</u>"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement upon the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, representations, and warranties contained in this Amendment, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged, the Parties, intending to be legally bound, agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Term.</u> County and Contractor hereby agree to extend the term of the Agreement for an additional period of one year, commencing on January 1, 2024, and expiring on December 31, 2024 (the "<u>First Extension Period</u>").
- 2. <u>Compensation</u>. The Parties agree to negotiate in good faith to establish the compensation to be paid to Contractor during the First Extension Period no later than December 31, 2023. If the Parties are unable to agree on the compensation to be paid to Contractor during the First Extension Period by December 31, 2023, then Contractor shall have the right and option to terminate the Agreement upon 60 days' prior written notice to County.
- 3. <u>Effect on Agreement</u>. Except as specifically amended hereby, the terms and provisions of the Agreement, and any amendments thereto, are in all other respects ratified and confirmed and remain in full force and effect without modification or limitation
- 4. <u>Governing Law</u>. This Amendment shall be governed by and construed under the laws of the State of Florida, without regard to principles of conflicts of law.
- 5. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Amendment may be executed simultaneously in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Faxed and e-mailed copies of manually executed signature pages to this Amendment will be fully binding and enforceable without the need for delivery of the original.







STATEMENT OF ISSUE: The Transit Department is requesting consideration of a fourth contract amendment to the MV Transportation Contract (C19-2761-TS). This contract amendment would cover a 12-month extension period from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, and will allow for negotiations to be held between Okaloosa County and MV Transportation to negotiate an adjusted revenue per hour rate, to accommodate market impacts in Okaloosa County and its surrounding area.

BACKGROUND: The Transit Department and the County's Transportation Contractor, MV Transportation, are entering its sixth year of transit partnership, that began in December 2018. This contract agreement included three amendments to address impacts of COVID-19, employment market for public transportation, and market value analysis addressing local wages. The proposed contract amendment will allow for continuing Transportation Services within Okaloosa County for a

12-Month Period from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, with the revenue per hour rate increasing from \$41.21 to \$42.44, as outlined in the third contract amendment.

Contract extension negotiations between the County and MV Transportation for an adjusted revenue per hour rate, will allow for continuous public transportation services within the County and its service area. If negotiations fail to reach a mutual agreement by December 31, 2023, a 60 Day Notice of Termination will be submitted by MV Transportation on January 1, 2024, with a last day of service on March 1, 2024.
