AGREEMENT NO. 19-265-9 AMENDMENT NUMBER 8

This Amendment Number 8 is made on $\frac{6/12/2023}{}$ by the County and amends Agreement Number 19-265-9 ("Main Agreement") dated August 12, 2019 between Sagres Construction Corporation ("Contractor") and the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia ("County").

The County and the Contractor agree to amend the Main Agreement as follows:

1. Section 4: **Time for Completion**

The Period of Performance for the Project shall be retroactively extended to December 31, 2023. The Project achieved Substantial Completion in December 2022. This extension is to allow the Contractor time to complete the following Final Completion items: 1) Install replacement Luminator mounting brackets that were redesigned and fabricated by Future Systems. 2) After Dominion Energy performs meter installations for the Phase 1 shelters (Glebe, Oakland, Buchanan and Four Mile Run Stations), the Contractor shall return to the site and make the final connections to the breakers within the meter pedestals and energize the stations' lights and real time displays.

2. Add the attached Proposed Change Order (PCO) 20 - temporary bus stop landings for Segment H/I stations, which is incorporated into and made a part of this Amendment. Contractor shall furnish and install temporary asphalt landings to accommodate boarding and de-boarding from the front and rear bus doors at the temporary bus stops located west of the Dinwiddie westbound stop, west of the Greenbrier eastbound stop and west of the Columbus eastbound stop.

3. Section 5: **Contract Amount**

This is a Fixed-Priced Contract Amendment 8 in the Not-To-Exceed amount of \$23,792.26 for this portion of the work.

PCO 20 - Temporary Bus Stops / Additional Work

Sagres Construction Corporation (Sagres) is pleased to submit for your consideration our Cost Estimate for the additional work indicated during our site visit to the aforesaid stations on 7/12/2022. This cost proposal has been completed to include all costs associated with required work as follows:

S. Dinwiddie Street EB Temporary Bus Station Landing

- (i) Removal of existing plantings in two areas located 23.5' (center to center). The dimensions of each area are 6'x6' for installation of landing. Each area extends from back of curb to edge of existing sidewalk. Specific locations are included in the attached sketch.
- (ii) Placement of 4-inch of VDOT 21A as subbase for the temporary landing.
- (iii) Placement of 2-inch of BM-25.0 asphalt base 21A as subbase for the temporary landing.

S. Columbus Street EB Temporary Bus Station Landing

- (i) Removal of existing plantings in two areas located 23.5' (center to center). The dimensions of each area are 6'x6' for installation of landing. Each area extends from back of the curb to edge of existing sidewalk. Specific locations are included in the attached sketch.
- (ii) Placement of 4-inch of VDOT 21A as subbase for the temporary landing.
- (iii) Placement of 2-inch of BM-25.0 asphalt base 21A as subbase for the temporary landing.

S. Columbus Street EB Temporary Bus Station Landing

- (i) Removal of existing plantings in two areas located 23.5' (center to center). The dimensions of one area is 6'x6' and the second area is 6'x2'due to the presence of an existing concrete inlet structure. The first area extends from back of curb to edge of existing sidewalk. Second area extends from edge of existing sidewalk to edge of existing concrete structure. Specific locations are included in the attached sketch.
- (ii) Placement of 4-inch of VDOT 21A as subbase for the temporary landing.
- (iii) Placement of 2-inch of BM-25.0 asphalt base 21A as subbase for the temporary landing

The attached cost proposal has been developed considering the following notes and exclusions:

- 1. Work shall be completed on or before 7/22/2022 under existing permits issued by Arlington County for upcoming stations on Segment H&I
- 2. Arlington County shall coordinate with Transportation Department for closing/relocation of each station at no cost to Sagres and notify Arlington County Transit Authority and users.
- 3. Arlington County shall notify all residents impacted by above indicated work in order to ensure safe pedestrian traffic.
- 4. Sagres will dispose of existing plantings in all indicated areas and remove any excess dirt from site.
- 5. Costs reflect personnel costs as per updated Prevailing Wages.
- 6. MOT has been estimated at 6% of contract value of this Additional Work.
- 7. Mobilization cost shall be per actual estimated rates.
- 8. Cost for Pre-Con Survey has been included.
