



Terms and conditions inconsistent with, contrary or in addition to the terms and conditions of this Participating Addendum and the NASPO Master Agreement, together with its exhibits, shall not be added to or incorporated into this Participating Addendum or the NASPO Master Agreement and its exhibits, by any subsequent Purchase Order or otherwise, and any such attempts to add or incorporate such terms and conditions are hereby rejected. The terms and conditions of this Participating Addendum and the NASPO Master Agreement and its exhibits shall prevail and govern in the case of any such inconsistent or additional terms.
