SCOPE OF SERVICES REVISION

This revises Item 5: Procedures for Task Order Project Assignments bullets a) and b) as follows:

- a) For task order Work assignments where the projected fee for all Work associated with that particular task will not exceed \$150,000, the County in its sole discretion may select the Contractor who is determined to be most qualified and best suited for this particular assignment.
 - If the Contractor's price proposal is unacceptable, the County will negotiate with the Contractor, and if no agreement is reached the County will request a price proposal from the next most-qualified Contractor. If the assignment is reasonably expected to evolve into a task order that, combined with the initial assignment, would exceed the \$150,000 threshold, the County will use the process specified under items b) or c) below (as applicable) to select the Contractor.
- b) For task order work assignments where the projected fee for all Work associated with that particular work is above \$150,000 but less than \$1,000,000, the County will solicit proposals from all Contractors selected as a result of this RFP. Upon selection by the County of the most-qualified Contractor, based on the County's pre-determined evaluation criteria, a fee proposal will be requested from that Contractor. If the price proposal is unacceptable, the County will negotiate with the Contractor, and if no agreement is reached, the County will request a price proposal from the next best qualified Contractor of those Contractors who submitted proposals. If the assignment is reasonably expected to evolve into a task order that, combined with the initial assignment, would exceed the \$1,000,000 threshold, the County will use the process specified under item c) below to select the Contractor.
