- Contract Pricing pg. 27 A.4. Most manufacturers will only held pricing for 1 year. Arlington is requesting prices be held for 2 years. Is this possible to request for prices to remain firm until August 1, 2017 instead of 2018?

RESPONSE: The County shall amend Paragraph Four (4) of Part III, Contract Terms and Conditions as follows:

CONTRACT PRICING WITH OPTIONAL PRICE ADJUSTMENT

The Contract amount/unit price(s) shall remain firm until <u>September 1, 2017 ("Price Adjustment Date")</u>. To request a price adjustment, the Contractor or the County must submit a written request to the other party not less than sixty (60) days prior to the Price Adjustment Date. Requests for adjustment(s) to Contract amount/unit price(s) for ensuing years shall not exceed the percentage of escalation / de-escalation in the U.S. Department of Labor, <u>Consumer Price Index</u>, All Items, Unadjusted, Urban Areas ("CPI-U") for the twelve (12) month period ending in <u>June</u> of each year of the Contract.

The Contractor shall submit a copy of the manufacturer's or wholesaler's current catalog prices at each subsequent renewal for this Contract. The manufacturer's or wholesaler's discount provided at the time of this Bid will apply to all Personal Protective Equipment and other related Equipment provided in the manufacturer's or wholesaler's catalog until the expiration of this Contract.

2. The options for the Globe Personal Protective Garments are not listed on the bid form. The written specifications request options for Brigade and Kombat Flex outer shells, Quantum 3D SL2i and Caldura NPi thermal liners, Crosstech 3-layer moisture barrier, Project Fires 2 trim style, Sew-on Letter Patch, Half High Expansion Pockets, Fairfax Spanner/Radio with ID Pocket, and 3 pack tool compartment, but there is not a place to price them on the bid form.

RESPONSE: Please see the amended Bid Form which is available as a separate download in eVA, Amended Bid Form. This Addendum A separates the various options for the requested coats and pants. See Attachments A-3 and A-4. The options LISTED in the amended Bid Form shall be individually priced. The options <u>UNLISTED</u> in the amended Bid Form, which include but not limited to: radio pocket or tool compartment, will be priced at catalog price minus the provided manufacturer's or wholesaler's discount.

3. Does a bidder have to supply a discount off of list for all of the supplemental information in Part 1 and Part 2 to be considered for award?

RESPONSE: No. The Bidder shall <u>ONLY</u> provide a manufacturer or wholesaler's discount on all items they are authorized to sell or service. No partial award will be accepted for items <u>LISTED</u> in Part One (1) and Part Two (2) of the Bid Form. Part Two (2) shall be awarded separately per section.

4. Due to the multiple manufacturers in Part 2, will the County be willing to award this Part by Line Item or Manufacturer/Brand?

Amended Part Two (2) of the Bid Form now only includes <u>Stations</u> <u>Garments and Other Related Equipment</u>. This Amended Part Two (2) shall be awarded to the Bidder with the lowest responsive bid per section. Each section, Station Garments and Other Related Equipment, shall be awarded separately per section.

5. Will the Classic Metro Spec include the components that are part of Arlington's current spec as the primary options since they have been proven over years of wear in the field specifically Crosstech Black Moisture barrier?

RESPONSE: Yes. See the amended Attachment A-3, A-4, and Bid Form. The County's elected options have been included into the amended specifications and Bid Form. The options that are <u>UNLISTED</u> in the amended Bid Form, will be purchased at catalog price minus the provided manufacturer's or wholesaler's discount.

Will this spec also include other components that are not currently listed? (e.g. Defender M thermal liner)

RESPONSE: Yes. See the amended Attachment A-3, A-4, and Bid Form. The County's elected options have been included into the amended specifications and Bid Form. The options that are <u>UNLISTED</u> in the amended Bid Form, will be purchased at catalog price minus the provided manufacturer's or wholesaler's discount.

7. If I understand it correctly, I must bid on all the gloves in part II section II to be compliant correct? What if I can only bid two brands?

RESPONSE: The County amends Part Two (2) of the Bid Form to remove Gloves. Amended Part Two (2) of the Bid Form now only includes <u>Stations Garments and Other Related Equipment</u>. Gloves shall be included into Part Three (3) and shall be awarded by Line Item.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for this section. The lowest responsible and responsive bidder will be determined by the following formula: County Estimated Quantity x Discounted Price = Extended Total

Add all Extended Totals in this Section. The Bidder with the lowest Extended Total will be awarded this section.

C. The County amends Part III, General Terms and Conditions as follows:

Paragraph Three (3) of Part III, Contract Terms and Conditions is amended as follows:

CONTRACT TERM

The Work shall commence on the date of the issuance of the Notice of Award, and shall be completed no later than <u>September 1, 2019</u> ("Initial Contract Term"), subject to any modifications as provided for in the Contract Documents. Upon satisfactory performance by the Contractor and with the concurrence of the Contractor, the County may, through issuance of an amendment executed by the parties, authorize continued operations of the Contractor for not more than six (6) additional twelve (12) month periods from <u>September 2, 2019 to September 1, 2025</u> (each such period shall be referred to as "Subsequent Contract Term").

- D. The County amends Attachments available as separate attachments in eVA (A-3 and A-4). The County also amends the Bid Form and adds it as a separate attachment in eVA, Amended Bid Form.
 - 1. The County adds the following helmets and additional requirement to Part Three (3) of the Bid Form:

Carins 1044 Helmet. This helmet shall be available in colors: black, red, and white. The optional colors for this helmet are yellow, blue, and orange. This helmet shall include ESS Goggles and Bourke Eye Shields.
