RESOLUTION NO. 17-332

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE LEASE OF TEN UNMARKED VEHICLES FROM ENTERPRISE LEASING COMPANY OF ORLANDO, LLC, FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2017, AND ENDING MARCH 29, 2018, AT A MONTHLY RATE OF \$631.51 PER VEHICLE, **INCORPORATING TERMS** GENERALLY THE CONDITIONS OF THE CITY OF PALM BAY POLICE DEPARTMENT PREFERRED RATE AGREEMENT: AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT WITH ENTERPRISE: AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 30-54(b), City Code, authorizes the City to make purchases from vendors who have entered into contracts with other governmental entities without competitive selection; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 16-270, the City Commission approved the Preferred Rate Agreement with Enterprise Leasing Company of Orlando, LLC ("Enterprise"), for the lease of ten unmarked vehicles from Enterprise for a period commencing October 1, 2016, and ending September 30, 2017, for a total annual amount not to exceed \$76,000, generally incorporating the terms and conditions of the City of Palm Bay Police Department Preferred Rate Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief desires to continue leasing the ten unmarked vehicles from Enterprise for the undercover unit using law enforcement trust funds, and has provided written certification that the request complies with the provisions of § 932.7055, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Enterprise has submitted an Amendment to Contract reflecting the new period of the lease to commence October 1, 2017, and end March 29, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The lease of ten unmarked vehicles from Enterprise Leasing Company of Orlando, LLC, for a period commencing October 1, 2017, and ending March 29, 2018, at a monthly rate of \$631.51 per vehicle, generally incorporating the terms and conditions of the City of Palm Bay Police Department Preferred Rate Agreement, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Amendment to Contract with Enterprise Leasing Company of Orlando, LLC. A copy of the Amendment in substantially final form is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

SECTION 3. In accordance with the requirement of § 932.7055(5)(b), Florida Statutes, the City Commission acknowledges receipt of the request and written certification of the Police Chief that the request complies with the provisions of § 932.7055, Florida Statutes, and hereby authorizes the expenditure of law enforcement trust funds for this purpose.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
