

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-100

A RESOLUTION APPROVING CONSTRUCTION SERVICES TERM CONTRACTS WITH SABOUNGI CONSTRUCTION, INC., AND MILITELLO CONCRETE CORPORATION, FOR AS NEEDED CONCRETE INSTALLATION, REMOVAL, DELIVERY, AND PLACEMENT SERVICES THROUGHOUT THE CITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000 ANNUALLY, FOR BOTH CONTRACTS COMBINED FOR A TWO YEAR TERM WITH TWO ONE-YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS FOR EACH CONTRACT PIGGYBACKING A VOLUSIA COUNTY CONTRACT (19-B-156IF); AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RENEW ANY OR ALL OF THESE CONTRACTS ON THE CITY'S BEHALF SUBJECT TO BUDGETING AND APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 30-54(b), City Code, authorizes the City to procure goods and services without the necessity of competitive selection pursuant to a piggyback contract; and

WHEREAS, the City is in need of installation, removal, and delivery of concrete and piggybacking from the Volusia County Contract (19-B-156IF) is the most efficient way for the City to access these services; and

WHEREAS, two contracts have been prepared, piggybacking Volusia County contracts with Saboungi Construction, Inc. and Militello Concrete Corp., to provide as-needed concrete installation, removal, delivery, and placement services throughout the City for a two-year term with two one-year renewal options for each contract; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director recommends approval of the two contracts; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the construction services term contracts with Saboungi Construction Inc., and Militello Concrete Corp. for as-needed concrete installation, removal, delivery, and placement services throughout the City in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 annually, for both contracts, combined, for a two year term with two one-year renewal options for each contract. A copy of each contract in substantially final form is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.


SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to renew any or all of the above-referenced contracts on the City's behalf, subject to budgeting and appropriation.
