### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

# OKALOOSA COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

#### AND

# NORTHWEST FLORIDA FAIRGROUNDS

This memorandum of understanding (MOU) is entered into this <u>21st</u> day of <u>June</u> 2005, between the OKALOOSA COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS and the NORTHWEST FLORIDA FAIRGROUNDS.

The purpose of this MOU is to set forth the general conditions under and by which the parties to this agreement will coordinate activities and resources for hardstand area "Parking lot" (see attached map), airlift warehouse space Building C (see attached map), sleeping area for crews Building A-3, RV hook-up areas behind main facilities (see attached map) and kitchen facilities behind Bldg A-3 of the Northwest Florida Fairgrounds as a County Staging Area (CSA) during disaster relief operations.

# Responsibilities:

The Okaloosa County Board of County Commissioners shall:

- 1. Occupy the facility for emergency operations until the threat/emergency ceases to exist.
- 2. Be responsible for custodial care and any maintenance repair that is incurred as a result of CSA operations.
- 3. Be responsible for trash collection and disposal during and immediately following a CSA operation.
- 4. Be responsible for all supplies, including food and bedding, to accommodate CSA occupants during operations.
- 5. Be responsible for utility costs used as a result of the occupancy as a CSA.
- 6. Indemnify Northwest Florida Fairgrounds against liability for anything caused by the County during the time used by the County as a CSA.
- 7. Obtain and install a temporary generator sufficient to provide power to the facilities as required for operations as a CSA.
- 8. Once an emergency is declared requiring the use of the Fairgrounds, Okaloosa County Emergency Management will contact Risk Management to order a certificate of insurance that will cover the Fairgrounds while it is being used by the County.

# Northwest Florida Fairgrounds Shall:

- 1. Provide the physical facilities, Bldg C, Bldg A-3, Kitchen Facilities, RV hook-up areas, and 25% of main parking area, for use as a CSA for relief supplies and personnel.
- 2. Provide access to male and female showers, and restroom facilities for on site CSA personnel.
- 3. Provide one Northwest Florida Fairgrounds employee on the premises at all times the facility is operational.
- 4. Provide access and use of the Fairgrounds Food Service Preparation area if necessary.
