

**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO SOLID WASTE ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES CONTRACT**

The City of Daytona Beach (the "City") and Redman Consulting Group, Inc. ("Contractor"), parties to the Solid Waste Administrative Services Contract dated August 26, 2010, and approved by City Resolution No. 10-219 (the "Contract"), hereby agree to amend the Contract as provided below.

1. The City and Contractor, having previously agreed to renew the Contract for the first of the five one-year renewal Terms referenced in Section 5 thereof, hereby agree as follows:

(i) The City will have the option to renew the Contract for an additional Term of four years at the expiration of the first Renewal Term, to wit: August 26, 2014.

(ii) The City will have the option to renew the Contract for an additional Term of five years at the expiration of the four-year Renewal Term referenced in Section 1, above, and ending on August 25, 2018.


(iii) The City may exercise the foregoing options by providing Contractor written notice of renewal at least 90 days before the end of the current Term.






